3 622.72 Expert witnesses — fee.

Witnesses called to testify only to an opinion founded on special study or experience in any branch of science, or to make scientific or professional examinations and state the result thereof, shall receive additional compensation, to be fixed by the court, with reference to the value of the time employed, and the degree of learning or skill required; but such additional compensation shall not exceed one hundred fifty dollars per day while so employed, and the reasonable and customary fees charged by similarly situated experts for similar services.

EXPLANATION

15 Current law provides that a court shall determine the amount 16 of fees to be awarded to an expert witness in a civil case 17 and in a criminal case except for an indigent criminal case 18 (Code section 815.5), upon consideration of the value of the 19 expert witness's time and degree of learning or skill required, 20 but such fees shall not exceed \$150 per expert per day. This 21 bill eliminates this limitation on the fee award and directs 22 the court to also consider the reasonable and customary fees 23 charged by similarly situated experts for similar services.
