- 1 Section 1. Section 602.1610, subsection 1, paragraph c,
- 2 Code 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 c. The mandatory retirement age is seventy-two years for
- 4 all district associate judges, associate juvenile judges,
- 5 associate probate judges, and judicial magistrates. However,
- 6 the mandatory retirement age does not apply to an associate
- 7 juvenile judge or associate probate judge who is seventy-two
- 8 years of age or older on July 1, 1996.
- 9 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICABILITY. This Act takes
- 10 effect January 1, 2013, and applies mandatory retirement on
- 11 January 1, 2013, to any associate juvenile judge or associate
- 12 probate judge who is seventy-two years of age or older on
- 13 January 1, 2013.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- This bill relates to the mandatory retirement age of certain 16 judicial officers.
- 17 The bill strikes a provision exempting an associate juvenile
- 18 judge or associate probate judge from the mandatory retirement
- 19 age of 72 years of age if the judge was 72 years of age or older
- 20 on July 1, 1996.
- 21 The bill takes effect January 1, 2013, and applies mandatory
- 22 retirement on January 1, 2013, to any associate juvenile judge
- 23 or associate probate judge who is 72 years of age or older on
- 24 January 1, 2013.
