- 1 Section 1. Section 598.41, subsection 3, paragraph f, Code 2 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 f. Whether the custody arrangement is in accord with the
- 4 child's wishes or whether the child has strong opposition,
- 5 taking into consideration the child's age and maturity. If a
- 6 child is fourteen years of age or older, the court shall allow
- 7 the child to express the child's wishes regarding custody by
- 8 oral testimony or deposition, unless the court determines that
- 9 doing so is not in the best interest of the child.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 This bill provides that in determining what custody
- 12 arrangement is in the best interest of a minor child, if a
- 13 child is 14 years of age or older, the court shall allow the
- 14 child to express the child's wishes regarding custody by oral
- 15 testimony or deposition, unless doing so is determined by the
- 16 court to not be in the best interest of the child.
