A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the operation of motorboats on artificial
- 2 lakes in the state, and including effective date provisions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 462A.31, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code
- 2 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. A motorboat equipped with any power unit mounted
- 4 or carried aboard the vessel may be operated at a no-wake
- 5 five-mile-per-hour speed on all artificial lakes of more than
- 6 one hundred acres in size under the custody of the department.
- 7 However, on lake Macbride, a motorboat with a power unit
- 8 exceeding ten horsepower may be operated only when permitted
- 9 by rule and the rule shall not authorize such use during the
- 10 period beginning on the Friday before Memorial Day and ending
- 11 on Labor Day inclusively. This paragraph does not limit
- 12 motorboat horsepower on natural lakes under the custody of the
- 13 department or limit the department's authority to establish
- 14 special speed zoning regulations.
- 15 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 16 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill provides that a motorboat may be operated at
- 19 a five-mile-per-hour speed on all artificial lakes of more
- 20 than 100 acres in size under the custody of the department of
- 21 natural resources. Currently, the speed limit for such lakes
- 22 is no-wake speed.
- 23 The bill also strikes a provision limiting the use of motors
- 24 exceeding 10 horsepower on lake Macbride during specified dates
- 25 during the summer.
- 26 The bill is effective upon enactment.
