A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to coverage under the medical assistance
- 2 program for the costs associated with the birth of a child
- 3 relinquished under the newborn safe haven Act.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 233.2, subsection 2, paragraph b, Code
2 2011, is amended to read as follows:

3 b. (1) A newborn infant admitted to a hospital in 4 accordance with this section and the infant's mother, for the 5 period of labor and delivery until the time of discharge of the 6 mother from the hospital, are presumed eligible for coverage 7 under the medical assistance program, subject to applicable 8 federal regulation.

9 (2) If the physical custody of the newborn infant is 10 relinquished at an institutional health facility, the state 11 shall reimburse the institutional health facility for the 12 institutional health facility's actual expenses in providing 13 care to the newborn infant and in performing acts necessary to 14 protect the physical health or safety of the newborn infant. 15 The reimbursement shall be paid from moneys appropriated for 16 this purpose to the department of human services.

17 Sec. 2. Section 233.6, Code 2011, is amended by adding the 18 following new subsection:

19 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 2A. Public information announcements and 20 other materials to develop awareness of the option for pregnant 21 women who wish to voluntarily release custody of the newborn 22 infant in accordance with this chapter to be eligible for 23 coverage under the medical assistance program for labor and 24 delivery charges and hospital costs associated with the birth 25 until the time of discharge from the hospital.

Sec. 3. MEDICAL ASSISTANCE COVERAGE OF HOSPITAL COSTS RELATED TO BIRTH OF CHILD UNDER THE NEWBORN SAFE HAVEN ACT. The department of human services shall amend the medical assistance state plan to provide for coverage of labor and delivery charges and the hospital costs associated with the lbirth of a child until the mother is discharged from the hospital, for a mother who wishes to voluntarily release custody by relinquishing physical custody of the child after birth pursuant to chapter 233.

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EXPLANATION

1 This bill provides for coverage under the medical assistance 2 program (Medicaid) of a newborn infant and the infant's mother 3 for labor and delivery and hospital charges associated with 4 the birth of a child until the mother is discharged from the 5 hospital, when the mother wishes to voluntarily release custody 6 by relinguishing physical custody of the newborn infant after 7 birth pursuant to Code chapter 233, the newborn safe haven Act. The bill directs the department of human services (DHS) 8 9 in consultation with the department of public health and 10 the department of justice, to distribute public information 11 announcements and other materials to develop awareness of the 12 option for pregnant women who wish to voluntarily release 13 custody of their newborn infant under the newborn safe haven 14 Act to be eligible for coverage under the Medicaid program for 15 labor and delivery charges and hospital costs associated with 16 the birth until the time of discharge from the hospital. The bill also directs DHS to amend the Medicaid state plan to 17 18 provide for the coverage described in the bill.

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
