A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to nomination papers filing deadlines for
- 2 school district and merged area elections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 260C.15, subsection 3, Code 2011, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3. Nomination papers on behalf of candidates for member of
- 4 the board of directors of a merged area shall be filed with
- 5 the secretary of the board not earlier than sixty-four one
- 6 hundred twenty days nor later than 5:00 p.m. on the fortieth
- 7 ninetieth day prior to the election at which members of the
- 8 board are to be elected. On the day following the last day
- 9 on which nomination petitions can be filed, and no later
- 10 than 5:00 p.m. on that day, the secretary shall deliver all
- 11 nomination petitions so filed, together with the text of any
- 12 public measure being submitted by the board of directors to
- 13 the electorate, to the county commissioner of elections who is
- 14 responsible under section 47.2 for conducting elections held
- 15 for the merged area. That commissioner shall certify the names
- 16 of candidates, and the text and summary of any public measure
- 17 being submitted to the electorate, to all county commissioners
- 18 of elections in the merged area by the thirty-fifth day prior
- 19 to the election.
- Sec. 2. Section 277.4, subsection 1, Code 2011, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 l. Nomination papers for all candidates for election
- 23 to office in each school district shall be filed with the
- 24 secretary of the school board not more than sixty-four one
- 25 hundred twenty days, nor less than forty ninety days before
- 26 the election. Nomination petitions shall be filed not later
- 27 than 5:00 p.m. on the last day for filing. If the school
- 28 board secretary is not readily available during normal office
- 29 hours, the secretary may designate a full-time employee of
- 30 the school district who is ordinarily available to accept
- 31 nomination papers under this section. On the final date for
- 32 filing nomination papers the office of the school secretary
- 33 shall remain open until 5:00 p.m.
- 34 EXPLANATION
- 35 This bill relates to filing deadlines for nomination papers

- 2 The bill requires that nomination papers for the election
- 3 of members of the board of directors of a merged area be filed
- 4 with the secretary of the merged area board not more than 120
- 5 days and not less than 90 days before an election for the
- 6 merged area. Current law requires that nomination papers be
- 7 filed not more than 64 days and not less than 40 days before
- 8 such elections.
- 9 The bill requires that nomination papers for all candidates
- 10 for election for a school district be filed with the secretary
- 11 of the school board not more than 120 days and not less than 90
- 12 days before an election for the school district. Current law
- 13 requires that nomination papers be filed not more than 64 days
- 14 and not less than 40 days before such elections.
