## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for a creativity and innovation task force.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.F. 220

- 1 Section 1. CREATIVITY AND INNOVATION TASK FORCE.
- 2 1. ESTABLISHMENT AND PURPOSE.
- 3 a. A creativity and innovation task force is established.
- 4 The task force shall be initially convened by July 1, 2011,
- 5 with staffing and administrative support provided by the
- 6 legislative services agency.
- 7 b. The task force shall be convened for the following
- 8 purposes:
- 9 (1) To foster the creation of new businesses in the state
- 10 and to increase the creation of jobs.
- 11 (2) To encourage and reward creativity, invention, and
- 12 innovation by Iowa residents.
- 13 2. MEMBERSHIP.
- 14 a. The task force shall consist of the following members:
- 15 (1) One member selected by the Iowa small business
- 16 development center.
- 17 (2) One member selected by the Iowa association of community
- 18 college trustees.
- 19 (3) One member selected by the John Pappajohn
- 20 entrepreneurial center at the university of Iowa.
- 21 (4) Two members selected by the Iowa bankers association
- 22 representing community bankers.
- 23 (5) Two members selected by the national federation of
- 24 independent business.
- 25 (6) Two members selected by the Iowa association of business
- 26 and industry.
- 27 (7) Two members selected by the professional developers of
- 28 Iowa.
- 29 b. The members shall be appointed in compliance with the
- 30 requirements of sections 69.16, 69.16A, and 69.19, and shall
- 31 serve for the duration of the task force.
- 32 c. The members of the task force are entitled to receive
- 33 reimbursement for actual expenses incurred while engaged in the
- 34 performance of official duties.
- 35 d. The task force shall elect a chairperson and the

- 1 recommendations of the task force shall be approved by
- 2 a majority of the members. A majority of the task force
- 3 constitutes a quorum and an affirmative vote of the majority
- 4 of members is necessary to approve the recommendations of the
- 5 task force. A vacancy in the membership does not impair the
- 6 right of a quorum to exercise all rights and perform all duties
- 7 of the task force.
- 8 3. DUTIES. The task force shall do all of the following:
- 9 a. Research and evaluate methods of encouraging and
- 10 rewarding innovation and entrepreneurship.
- ll b. Create a forum and a process for listening to and
- 12 addressing the concerns of inventors and entrepreneurs.
- 13 c. Develop ideas for identifying innovations that have the
- 14 potential to become successful new businesses in the state.
- d. Recommend a process for helping inventors and innovators
- 16 commercialize inventions and innovations.
- 17 e. Identify the barriers to business creation and expansion
- 18 and the hurdles inhibiting the commercialization of research.
- 19 4. REPORT. The task force shall submit a written report
- 20 containing its findings and recommendations to the governor
- 21 and the general assembly by January 1, 2012. The report shall
- 22 include a plan for facilitating the development of programs
- 23 that enhance the commercialization of research.
- 24 5. DISSOLUTION. The task force shall complete its duties
- 25 no later than January 1, 2012, but may complete its duties and
- 26 dissolve itself prior to that date.
- 27 EXPLANATION
- 28 This bill establishes a creativity and innovation task
- 29 force. The task force must be convened by July 1, 2011.
- 30 The task force is to be convened for the following purposes:
- 31 (1) to foster the creation of new businesses in the state and
- 32 to increase the creation of jobs; and (2) to encourage and
- 33 reward creativity, invention, and innovation by Iowa residents.
- 34 The task force consists of one member selected by the Iowa
- 35 small business development center, one member selected by the

- 1 Iowa association of community college trustees, one member
- 2 selected by the John Pappajohn entrepreneurial center, two
- 3 members selected by the Iowa bankers association representing
- 4 community bankers, two members selected by the national
- 5 federation of independent business, two members selected by
- 6 the Iowa association of business and industry, and two members
- 7 selected by the professional developers of Iowa.
- 8 The task force has certain duties related to new ideas and
- 9 methods for fostering job creation and encouraging creativity,
- 10 and must file a report with the general assembly and the
- 11 governor by January 1, 2012, when the task force is dissolved.
