(SUCCESSOR TO SSB 1038)

A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to employment services laws administered by the
2 division of labor services of the department of workforce
3 development.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 88A.4, subsection 1, Code 2011, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. Late submission processing fee for permit
4 applications submitted after the first of May deadline, one
5 hundred dollars.

6 Sec. 2. Section 89.3, subsection 8, Code 2011, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 ~~8. Internal inspections~~ Inspections of unfired steam
9 pressure vessels operating in excess of fifteen pounds per
10 square inch and low pressure steam boilers shall be conducted
11 ~~once every two years. External inspections shall be conducted~~
12 annually. at least once each calendar year. The inspections
13 in each two-year period shall include an external inspection
14 conducted while the boiler is operating and an internal
15 inspection. At least six months shall pass between these
16 inspections. An internal inspection of an unfired steam
17 pressure vessel may be required at any time by the commissioner
18 upon the observation by an inspector of conditions, enumerated
19 by the commissioner through rules, warranting an internal
20 inspection.

21 Sec. 3. Section 89A.13, subsection 2, Code 2011, is amended
22 to read as follows:

23 2. The safety board is composed of nine members, one
24 of whom shall be the commissioner or the commissioner's
25 designee. The governor shall appoint the remaining eight
26 members of the board, subject to senate confirmation, to
27 staggered four-year terms which shall begin and end as provided
28 in section 69.19. The members shall be as follows: two
29 representatives from an elevator manufacturing company or
30 its authorized representative; two representatives from
31 elevator servicing companies; one building owner or manager;
32 ~~one representative employed by a local government in this~~
33 ~~state who is knowledgeable about building codes in this state;~~
34 citizen of this state who is knowledgeable about conveyances;
35 one representative of workers actively involved in the

1 installation, maintenance, and repair of elevators; and one
2 licensed mechanical engineer.

3 Sec. 4. Section 90A.2, subsection 2, Code 2011, is amended
4 to read as follows:

5 2. The license application shall be in the form prescribed
6 by the commissioner and shall contain information that is
7 substantially complete and accurate. Any change in the
8 information provided in the application shall be reported
9 promptly to the commissioner. The application shall be
10 submitted no later than ~~seven~~ thirty days prior to the intended
11 date of the match.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill provides for an additional \$100 fee for an
14 amusement ride operator who submits a late permit application.

15 The bill provides for required inspections of certain
16 boilers to occur at least once a year, but not more than once
17 every six months. The bill provides that such inspections
18 shall include one internal inspection and one external
19 inspection in each two-year period.

20 The bill replaces the requirement that the membership of
21 the elevator safety board include a representative employed by
22 a local government who is knowledgeable about state building
23 codes with a requirement that it include a citizen of Iowa who
24 is knowledgeable about conveyances.

25 The bill provides that an application for an event license
26 for a professional boxing or wrestling or mixed martial arts
27 match must be made no later than 30 days before the match is to
28 occur. Current law requires an application to be made no later
29 than seven days before an event.
