- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 261.86, subsection 6, Code 2011, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 6. Notwithstanding section 8.33, until one year after the
- 4 date the president of the United States or the Congress of
- 5 the United States declares a cessation of hostilities ending
- 6 operation Iraqi freedom, operation new dawn, and operation
- 7 enduring freedom, funds appropriated for purposes of this
- 8 section which remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close
- 9 of the fiscal year for which the funds were appropriated shall
- 10 not revert but shall be available for expenditure for the
- 11 following fiscal year for purposes of this section.
- 12 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT AND RETROACTIVE
- 13 APPLICABILITY. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
- 14 takes effect upon enactment and applies retroactively to
- 15 September 1, 2010.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- 17 This bill provides that funds appropriated for the national
- 18 quard education assistance program shall not revert to the
- 19 general fund of the state but shall be available for use by
- 20 the program for the next fiscal year until one year after the
- 21 declared end of operation Iraqi freedom, operation new dawn,
- 22 and operation enduring freedom. Operation Iraqi freedom ended
- 23 on August 31, 2010, and was succeeded by operation new dawn on
- 24 September 1, 2010. The bill takes effect upon enactment and
- 25 applies retroactively to September 1, 2010.
