A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the examination requirements for an
- 2 applicant for a noncommercial driver's license.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.178, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code 2 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 c. Every public school district in Iowa shall offer or make
- 4 available to all students residing in the school district or
- 5 Iowa students attending a nonpublic school in the district an
- 6 approved course in driver education. The receiving district
- 7 shall be the school district responsible for making driver
- 8 education available to a student participating in open
- 9 enrollment under section 282.18. The courses may be offered
- 10 at sites other than at the public school, including nonpublic
- ll school facilities within the public school districts. An
- 12 approved course offered during the summer months, on Saturdays,
- 13 after regular school hours during the regular terms or partly
- 14 in one term or summer vacation period and partly in the
- 15 succeeding term or summer vacation period, as the case may
- 16 be, shall satisfy the requirements of this section to the
- 17 same extent as an approved course offered during the regular
- 18 school hours of the school term. A student who successfully
- 19 completes and obtains certification in an approved course in
- 20 driver education or an approved course in motorcycle education
- 21 may, upon proof of such fact, be excused from any field test
- 22 which the student would otherwise be required to take in
- 23 demonstrating the student's ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- 24 A student shall not be excused from any field test if a parent,
- 25 guardian, or instructor requests that a test be administered.
- 26 A final field test prior to a student's completion of an
- 27 approved course shall be administered by a person qualified
- 28 as a classroom driver education instructor and certified to
- 29 provide street and highway driving instruction. A person
- 30 qualified as a classroom driver education instructor but not
- 31 certified to provide street and highway driving instruction
- 32 may administer the final field test if accompanied by another
- 33 person qualified to provide street and highway driving
- 34 instruction.
- 35 Sec. 2. Section 321.186, subsection 1, Code 2011, is amended

1 to read as follows:

- The department may shall examine every new applicant
- 3 for a driver's license or and may examine any person holding
- 4 a valid driver's license when the department has reason
- 5 to believe that the person may be physically or mentally
- 6 incompetent to operate a motor vehicle, or whose driving
- 7 record appears to the department to justify the examination.
- 8 The department shall make every effort to accommodate a
- 9 functionally illiterate applicant when the applicant is taking
- 10 a knowledge test. The department shall make every effort
- 11 to have an examiner conduct the commercial driver's license
- 12 driving skills tests at other locations in this state where
- 13 skills may be adequately tested when requested by a person
- 14 representing ten or more drivers requiring driving skills
- 15 testing.
- 16 Sec. 3. Section 321.188, subsection 2, unnumbered paragraph
- 17 1, Code 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 An Notwithstanding section 321.186, an applicant for a
- 19 commercial driver's license may substitute for a driving skills
- 20 test the applicant's operating record and previous passage of
- 21 a driving skills test or the applicant's operating record and
- 22 previous driving experience if all of the following conditions
- 23 exist:
- 24 EXPLANATION
- 25 Under current law, the department of transportation is
- 26 authorized to examine every person who applies for a driver's
- 27 license, as well as any person holding a valid driver's license
- 28 when the department has reason to believe the person may be
- 29 physically or mentally incompetent to drive or whose driving
- 30 record appears to justify the examination. The department can
- 31 waive examination requirements for a new resident who has a
- 32 valid driver's license from another state. In addition, the
- 33 department can waive the driving skills test for a student who
- 34 successfully completes an approved driver's education course.
- 35 This bill requires the department to fully examine every

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- 1 applicant for a noncommercial driver's license.
- 2 Pursuant to current law, an examination for a driver's
- 3 license includes a test of the applicant's eyesight, a test
- 4 of the applicant's ability to read and understand highway
- 5 signs, a test of the applicant's knowledge of traffic laws, a
- 6 demonstration of the applicant's ability to exercise ordinary
- 7 and reasonable control in the operation of a motor vehicle,
- 8 and any other physical or mental examinations the department
- 9 deems necessary to determine an applicant's fitness to operate
- 10 a motor vehicle safely.
- Under the bill, an applicant for a commercial driver's
- 12 license may continue to substitute for a driving skills test
- 13 the applicant's operating record and previous passage of an
- 14 equivalent driving skills test or the applicant's operating
- 15 record and previous driving experience.
