## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to required mediation as part of a custody
- 2 order.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 598.41, Code 2011, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 7A. a. Any order awarding joint custody
- 4 of a child may require the parents to participate in mediation
- 5 subsequent to the granting of the award, at the request of
- 6 either party, or if the court determines that participation by
- 7 the parents in mediation is in the best interest of the child.
- 8 b. The court shall not require participation in mediation if
- 9 the court determines that a history of domestic abuse exists as
- 10 specified in subsection 3, paragraph j'', or unless the court
- 11 determines that direct physical harm or significant emotional
- 12 harm to the child, other children, or a parent is likely to
- 13 result.
- c. Mediation performed under this subsection shall comply
- 15 with the provisions of chapter 679C.
- 16 d. The costs of mediation shall be borne by the parties, as
- 17 agreed to by the parties, or as ordered by the court, and may be
- 18 taxed as court costs. Mediation shall be provided on a sliding
- 19 scale for parties who are determined to be indigent pursuant
- 20 to section 815.9.
- 21 EXPLANATION
- 22 This bill provides that in any order awarding joint custody
- 23 of a child, the court may require the parents to participate in
- 24 mediation subsequent to the granting of the order, if either
- 25 parent so requests or if the court determines that it is in
- 26 the best interest of the child. Participation is not to be
- 27 required if a history of domestic abuse exists, or if the court
- 28 determines that direct physical harm or significant emotional
- 29 harm to the child, other children, or a parent is likely to
- 30 result. Mediation is to comply with the provisions of Code
- 31 chapter 679C (Mediation) and the costs of mediation are to be
- 32 borne by the parties as agreed to by the parties, or as ordered
- 33 by the court. Mediation is to be provided on a sliding fee
- 34 schedule for those determined to be indigent.
