- 6 ward's family concerning the department's actions relating to
- 7 the removal and including a detailed inventory of the ward's
- 8 clothing, furniture, vehicle, and other personal effects at the
- 9 time of removal and their current status.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 633.641, Code 2011, is amended by adding the
- 11 following new unnumbered paragraph:
- 12 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. If the conservator is the
- 13 department of human services and the ward is removed from the
- 14 ward's residence, the department shall provide an affidavit to
- 15 the ward's family concerning the department's actions relating
- 16 to the removal and including a detailed inventory of the ward's
- 17 clothing, furniture, vehicle, and other personal effects at the
- 18 time of removal and their current status.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- 20 This bill relates to the duties of the department of human
- 21 services when serving as a guardian or conservator by amending
- 22 Code section 633.635, relating to the responsibilities of a
- 23 quardian, and Code section 633.641, relating to the duties of
- 24 a conservator.
- 25 If the department is serving as a guardian or conservator and
- 26 the ward is removed from the ward's residence, the department
- 27 is required to provide an affidavit to the ward's family
- 28 concerning the department's actions relating to the removal
- 29 and including a detailed inventory of the ward's clothing,
- 30 furniture, vehicle, and other personal effects at the time of
- 31 removal and their current status.
