A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring birth certificates to be filed with affidavits
- 2 of candidacy for presidential and vice presidential
- 3 candidates.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 368

- Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **45.3A** Filing of birth certificates 2 presidential and vice presidential candidates.
- 1. A candidate for president or vice president shall attach
 4 to and file with the affidavit of candidacy a copy of the
 5 candidate's birth certificate certified by the appropriate
 6 official in the candidate's state of birth. The certified copy
- 7 shall be made part of the affidavit of candidacy and shall be
- $\boldsymbol{8}$ made available for public inspection in the same manner as the
- 9 affidavit of candidacy.
- 2. A candidate for president or vice president who does 11 not comply with the requirements of this section shall not 12 be eligible for placement on the ballot as a candidate for 13 president or vice president anywhere in the state.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- This bill provides that candidates for president and vice 16 president shall file, along with their affidavit of candidacy, 17 a certified copy of the candidate's birth certificate which
- 18 shall be made available for public inspection in the same
- 19 manner as the candidate's affidavit of candidacy. The bill
- 20 further provides that a candidate for president or vice
- 21 president who does not attach to the affidavit of candidacy a
- 22 certified copy of the candidate's birth certificate shall not
- 23 be eligible for placement on the ballot anywhere in the state.
