## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the issuance of a permit to carry weapons.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.F. 372

- 1 Section 1. Section 724.11, subsection 4, Code 2011, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 4. The sheriff or commissioner of public safety shall
- 4 approve or deny an initial or renewal application submitted
- 5 under this section within thirty five business days of receipt
- 6 of the application. A person whose application for a permit
- 7 under this chapter is denied may seek review of the denial
- 8 under section 724.21A. The failure to approve or deny an
- 9 initial or renewal application shall result in a decision of
- 10 approval.
- 11 Sec. 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. The general assembly finds
- 12 that there is an urgent need for Iowa sheriffs to be diligent
- 13 and timely in processing applications for permits to carry
- 14 weapons in an effort to assure compliance with the applicable
- 15 rules and laws governing the issuance of permits to carry
- 16 weapons.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill amends current law requiring the sheriff or
- 19 commissioner of public safety to approve or deny an initial or
- 20 renewal application for a permit to carry weapons from within
- 21 30 days of receipt of an application to within five business
- 22 days of receipt of an application.
- 23 The bill further provides that the general assembly finds
- 24 that there is an urgent need for Iowa sheriffs to be diligent
- 25 and timely in processing applications for permits to carry
- 26 weapons in an effort to assure compliance with the applicable
- 27 rules and laws governing the issuance of permits to carry
- 28 weapons.
