A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to whistleblower protection for state employees
- 2 and making penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 70A.28, Code 2011, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. It shall not be a defense to an
- 4 alleged violation of subsection 1 or 2 that a person alleged
- 5 to have violated subsection 1 or 2 was acting within the scope
- 6 of the employee's office or employment as defined in section
- 7 669.2, subsection 1. The penalty and remedial provisions of
- 8 subsections 4 through 6 apply to a violation of subsection 1
- 9 or 2 by such a person.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 This bill prohibits the assertion of a scope of employment
- 12 defense within the meaning of Code section 669.2(1) by an
- 13 employee of the state alleged to have violated the state
- 14 whistleblower law. The bill applies the penalty and remedial
- 15 provisions of the state whistleblower law to such an employee.
- 16 Under Code section 70A.28(4), a violation of the bill is a
- 17 simple misdemeanor. A simple misdemeanor is punishable by
- 18 confinement for no more than 30 days or a fine of at least
- 19 \$65 but not more than \$625 or both. Civil and administrative
- 20 remedies also apply.
