- 1 An Act relating to railroad crossing violations by providing
- 2 for investigations, and providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.344A, subsection 2, unnumbered
- 2 paragraph 1, Code 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 A peace officer may shall initiate an investigation not
- 4 more than seven calendar days after receiving a report of a
- 5 violation pursuant to this section. The peace officer may
- 6 request that the owner of the vehicle supply information
- 7 identifying the driver of the vehicle in accordance with
- 8 section 321.484, or in the case of a commercial motor vehicle,
- 9 the peace officer may request that the employer of the driver
- 10 provide information identifying the driver of the vehicle.
- 11 Sec. 2. Section 805.8A, subsection 14, paragraph h, Code
- 12 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 h. Railroad crossing violations.
- 14 (1) For violations under sections 321.341, 321.342,
- 15 321.343, and 321.344, and 321.344B, the scheduled fine is two
- 16 hundred dollars.
- 17 (2) For a violation under section 321.344B, the scheduled
- 18 fine is three hundred dollars.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- 20 This bill requires a peace officer's investigation of every
- 21 reported railroad crossing violation by a vehicle operator.
- 22 Currently, the initiation of an investigation is optional.
- 23 The bill increases the scheduled fine for a railroad
- 24 crossing violation by a vehicle operator which creates an
- 25 immediate threat to the safety of a person or property from
- 26 \$200 to \$300. All other railroad crossing violations remain
- 27 punishable by a scheduled fine of \$200.
