- 1 An Act relating to the use of statewide school infrastructure
- 2 funding.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 424

- 1 Section 1. Section 297.22, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
- 2 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. The board of directors of a school district may sell,
- 4 lease, exchange, give, or grant, and accept any interest
- 5 in real property to, with, or from a county, municipal
- 6 corporation, school district, community college for a joint
- 7 infrastructure project authorized under section 423F.3,
- 8 subsection 3, paragraph "a", township, or area education agency
- 9 if the real property is within the jurisdiction of both the
- 10 grantor and grantee.
- 11 Sec. 2. Section 423F.3, subsection 3, paragraph a, Code
- 12 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 a. If the board of directors adopts a resolution to use
- 14 funds received under the operation of this chapter solely
- 15 for providing property tax relief by reducing indebtedness
- 16 from the levies specified under section 298.2 or 298.18 or,
- 17 notwithstanding the requirement that a school district have
- 18 exclusive jurisdiction in all matters within the territory
- 19 of the school district under section 274.1, for a joint
- 20 infrastructure project with one or more school districts or
- 21 one or more school districts and an Iowa community college,
- 22 the board of directors may approve a revenue purpose statement
- 23 for that purpose such purposes without submitting the revenue
- 24 purpose statement to a vote of the electors.
- 25 EXPLANATION
- 26 This bill authorizes the board of directors of a school
- 27 district, by resolution, to use local sales and services
- 28 tax revenue received under Code chapter 423F for a joint
- 29 infrastructure project with one or more school districts or
- 30 one or more school districts and an Iowa community college,
- 31 following approval of a revenue purpose statement, without
- 32 submitting the revenue purpose statement approving such use of
- 33 funds to a vote of the electors.
- 34 The bill adds community colleges to the list of entities
- 35 that a board of directors of a school district may sell, lease,

- 1 exchange, give, or grant, and accept any interest in real
- 2 property to, with, or from if the real property is within the
- 3 jurisdiction of both the grantor and grantee and it is for a
- 4 joint infrastructure project with one or more school districts
- 5 and an Iowa community college.
