A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act creating, within the department of public health, a Lyme
- 2 disease task force.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 432

- 1 Section 1. LYME DISEASE TASK FORCE. The department of
- 2 public health shall form an ad hoc task force of no more than
- 3 eleven members to comprehensively review all current studies
- 4 and other literature relating to the recognition and treatment
- 5 of Lyme disease. Based on that information the task force
- 6 shall develop recommendations for health care provider training
- 7 for the prevention, detection, and treatment of Lyme disease.
- 8 1. Task force membership. The department shall appoint
- 9 members to the task force from a variety of health-related
- 10 backgrounds and who represent government, academia, and
- 11 industry. One member shall be a patient or physician
- 12 representative of the Iowa Lyme disease association.
- Task force organization and operation.
- 14 a. The task force shall select its own chairperson and
- 15 establish its rules of procedure. A majority of the members of
- 16 the task force shall constitute a quorum.
- 17 b. Members shall serve without compensation, but may be
- 18 reimbursed for actual expenses if funds are available.
- 19 c. The task force shall meet as deemed necessary by
- 20 the chairperson. In addition, the task force should, if
- 21 practicable, hold at least one public hearing to accept input
- 22 from interested members of the public.
- 23 d. The department of public health shall provide staff
- 24 support for the task force.
- 25 3. Report. The task force shall submit recommendations to
- 26 the general assembly and the governor on or before January 15,
- 27 2012.
- 28 4. Termination. The task force shall terminate upon
- 29 submission of its report to the general assembly.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 This bill creates the Lyme disease task force, staffed by
- 32 the department of public health. Its purpose is to develop
- 33 recommendations for health care provider training for the
- 34 prevention, detection, and treatment of Lyme disease. Members
- 35 do not receive per diem, but may receive expense payments if

- 1 funds are available. The bill defines task force membership,
- 2 calls for a public hearing to garner public comment, and
- 3 establishes basic rules for the task force. The task force is
- 4 required to submit recommendations to the general assembly and
- 5 the governor on or before January 15, 2012.
- 6 The task force terminates upon submission of its report.
