SENATE FILE 498 BY BOLKCOM

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing a meatpacking industry workers bill of
- 2 rights.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 84A.12 Meatpacking industry workers
- 2 bill of rights duties and authority of coordinator.
- 3 1. The position of meatpacking industry worker rights
- 4 coordinator is established within the division of labor
- 5 services and under the direction and control of the labor
- 6 commissioner. The coordinator shall be appointed by the
- 7 governor and serve at the pleasure of the governor. Preference
- 8 shall be given to applicants for the coordinator position who
- 9 are fluent in the Spanish language.
- 10 2. The duties of the coordinator shall be to inspect and
- 11 review the practices and procedures of meatpacking operations
- 12 in this state as they relate to the provision of the Iowa
- 13 meatpacking industry worker bill of rights, which rights are
- 14 outlined as follows:
- 15 a. The right to organize as protected by chapter 731.
- 16 b. The right to a safe workplace.
- 17 c. The right to adequate facilities and the opportunity to
- 18 use them.
- 19 d. The right to complete information.
- 20 e. The right to understand the information provided.
- 21 f. The right to existing state and federal benefits and
- 22 rights.
- 23 q. The right to be free from discrimination.
- 24 h. The right to continuing training, including training of
- 25 supervisors.
- 26 i. The right to compensation for work performed.
- 27 j. The right to seek state help.
- 28 3. The coordinator and the coordinator's designated
- 29 representatives shall have access to all meatpacking operations
- 30 in this state at any time meatpacking products are being
- 31 processed and industry workers are on the job.
- 32 4. The coordinator may issue a subpoena to compel any
- 33 person to appear, give sworn testimony, or produce documentary
- 34 or other evidence relevant to the duties of the coordinator
- 35 authorized under this section. If any person subpoenaed

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- 1 refuses to produce the records, books, or papers, the
- 2 coordinator may apply to the district court having jurisdiction
- 3 over that person for the enforcement of the subpoena.
- 4 5. The coordinator may receive complaints and make
- 5 referrals to appropriate government agencies as necessary to
- 6 enforce the provisions of this section.
- 7 6. The commissioner shall provide necessary office space,
- 8 furniture, equipment, and supplies as well as necessary
- 9 assistance for the coordinator.
- 7. The coordinator shall, on or before December 1 of each
- 11 year, submit a report to the members of the general assembly
- 12 and the governor regarding any actions the coordinator deems
- 13 necessary or appropriate to provide for the fair treatment of
- 14 workers in the meatpacking industry.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- 16 This bill establishes a meatpacking industry workers bill of
 - 7 rights. The bill creates a position of meatpacking industry
- 18 worker rights coordinator within the division of labor services
- 19 of the department of workforce development to be appointed by
- 20 the governor and who shall grant preference to Spanish-speaking
- 21 applicants. The bill grants to the coordinator the right to
- 22 inspect and review the practices and procedures of meatpacking
- 23 operations to ensure specific rights of meatpacking workers as
- 24 enumerated in the bill. The coordinator is granted access to
- 25 all meatpacking operations in Iowa, may issue subpoenas, compel
- 26 testimony or documentary evidence, and enforce the subpoenas
- 27 in district court. The coordinator may receive complaints,
- 28 make referrals to government agencies, and must make an annual
- 29 report to the general assembly and governor. Office space,
- 30 equipment, and general direction and control shall be provided
- 31 by the labor commissioner although the coordinator serves at
- 32 the pleasure of the governor.
