## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring the sale of the Honey creek premier
- 2 destination park and including effective date provisions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 463C.19A Sale of Honey creek 2 premier destination park.
- 3 l. Immediately after the effective date of this Act, the
- 4 Honey creek premier destination park authority shall develop a
- 5 plan to sell, at market value, the tract of land referred to as
- 6 the Honey creek premier destination park on the north shore of
- 7 Rathbun lake in Appanoose county. The plan shall include the
- 8 sale of substantial portions of the tract as soon as practical,
- 9 and the sale of all of the tract within a commercially
- 10 reasonable time. Prior to implementing the plan, the authority
- 11 shall submit the plan to the natural resource commission for
- 12 review and approval. The sale shall be handled in a manner
- 13 that is the most financially beneficial to the authority.
- 14 Appraisals conducted by the authority of the value of any
- 15 portion of the tract shall be made available to the public
- 16 immediately following the sale of that portion of the tract.
- 17 2. The proceeds from the sale of the property as provided
- 18 in subsection 1 are appropriated to and shall be used by
- 19 the authority to pay all outstanding bonds and satisfy all
- 20 outstanding obligations of the authority, including fulfilling
- 21 any outstanding covenants or provisions with bondholders or
- 22 third parties made in accordance with this chapter, and any
- 23 remaining proceeds are appropriated to and shall be used by the
- 24 natural resource commission to maintain other parks and public
- 25 lands under the jurisdiction of the commission.
- 3. By December 15 annually, the natural resource commission
- 27 shall submit a report of the activities and costs of the sale
- 28 of any property in accordance with subsection 1, including but
- 29 not limited to the use of any proceeds from the sale of the
- 30 property, to the general assembly in accordance with section
- 31 7A.11A, and to the legislative services agency, until such
- 32 time as the sale of the property is complete and the proceeds
- 33 have been expended by the authority, at which time the natural
- 34 resource commission shall submit a final report on the sale of
- 35 the property and use of the proceeds to the general assembly in

- 1 accordance with section 7A.11A and to the legislative services
- 2 agency.
- 3 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 4 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 5 EXPLANATION
- 6 This bill requires the Honey creek premier destination
- 7 park authority to develop a plan to sell the Honey creek
- 8 premier destination park which is located on the north shore of
- 9 Rathbun lake in Appanoose county. The plan must be reviewed
- 10 and approved by the natural resource commission prior to
- 11 implementation.
- 12 Proceeds from the sale of the property are appropriated to
- 13 the authority to pay all outstanding bonds and satisfy all
- 14 outstanding obligations of the authority, including fulfilling
- 15 any outstanding covenants or provisions with bondholders or
- 16 third parties made in accordance with Code chapter 463C and any
- 17 remaining proceeds are appropriated to and shall be used by the
- 18 commission to maintain and manage other parks and public lands
- 19 under the jurisdiction of the commission.
- 20 The natural resource commission is required to submit an
- 21 annual report of the activities and costs of the sale of
- 22 the property to the general assembly and to the legislative
- 23 services agency, including the use of any proceeds from the
- 24 sale, until the sale of the property is complete and all
- 25 proceeds have been expended, at which time the commission shall
- 26 submit a final report.
- 27 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
