SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 104

- 1 A Resolution to preserve habeas corpus and civil
- 2 liberties.
- 3 WHEREAS, one of our most fundamental rights as
- 4 American citizens is to be free from unreasonable
- 5 detention without due process of law, a right afforded
- 6 to us by our founding fathers and quaranteed to us by
- 7 over two centuries of sacrifice by our men and women in
- 8 the armed forces whom we daily recognize and honor; and
- 9 WHEREAS, on behalf of the citizens of Iowa, the
- 10 Senate opposes any and all laws, regulations, and
- 11 executive orders, which amount to an overreach of the
- 12 federal government and which effectively take away
- 13 civil liberties; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in accordance with the Constitution of the
- 15 State of Iowa, Article III, section 32, all members
- 16 of the General Assembly are mandated to "support the
- 17 Constitution of the United States, and the Constitution
- 18 of the State of Iowa,"; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the members of the Senate believe that any
- 20 laws, regulations, or executive orders going against
- 21 habeas corpus or the civil liberties of Iowa citizens
- 22 granted under the Constitution of the United States
- 23 and Bill of Rights are invalid and should not be
- 24 recognized; NOW THEREFORE,
- 25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the Senate urges
- 26 the members of the United States Congress to resist
- 27 any attempt to curtail or restrict the right of due
- 28 process and the right to habeas corpus as guaranteed in

- 1 the Bill of Rights and the Constitution of the United
- 2 States and to repeal those provisions of the federal
- 3 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012
- 4 which threaten those rights; and
- 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That an official copy of
- 6 this Resolution be transmitted to the President of
- 7 the United States, the Secretary of the United States
- 8 Department of Defense, and to members of the Iowa
- 9 Congressional delegation.
