## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 12

- 1 A Resolution to recognize the centennial of the
- 2 establishment of the Republic of China on Taiwan.
- 3 WHEREAS, National Celebration Day, also known as
- 4 Double Ten Day, is celebrated every year on October
- 5 10th to commemorate the 1911 Wuchang Uprising, which
- 6 led to the collapse of the Qing Dynasty in China; and
- 7 WHEREAS, that milestone was quickly followed by the
- 8 establishment of the Republic of China (Taiwan) on
- 9 January 1, 1912, under the leadership of the visionary
- 10 Dr. Sun Yat-sen; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Republic of China (Taiwan) is both the
- 12 first and the oldest republic in Asia; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the Republic of China (Taiwan) is a vibrant
- 14 democracy and economic powerhouse that protects
- 15 human rights, governs through the rule of law, and
- 16 continually seeks participation in international
- 17 affairs; NOW THEREFORE,
- 18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the members of
- 19 the Senate offer their congratulations to President Ma
- 20 Ying-jeou on the centennial year of the founding of the
- 21 Republic of China (Taiwan) and a century of social,
- 22 political, and economic achievements; and
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of
- 24 the Senate is directed to deliver a copy of this
- 25 resolution to the Taiwan Embassy in the United States
- 26 and to President Ma Ying-jeou of the Republic of China
- 27 (Taiwan).
