## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring hospitals and outpatient surgical facilities
- 2 to report data on the use of a registered nurse as a
- 3 circulating nurse during surgical procedures and including
- 4 effective date provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 135.75A Data reporting on
- 2 circulating nurse in operating room.
- 3 1. a. A hospital or outpatient surgical facility, as
- 4 defined in section 135.61, shall keep written records regarding
- 5 the use of circulating nurses in each separate operating room
- 6 where surgery is being performed.
- 7 b. For purposes of this section, "circulating nurse" means
- 8 a registered nurse, qualified by training and experience
- 9 in operating room nursing, who is present in an operating
- 10 room where surgery is being performed for the duration of
- 11 the operative procedure. Instances of a circulating nurse
- 12 leaving the operating room as part of the operative procedure,
- 13 leaving the operating room for short periods or, in accordance
- 14 with employer rules or regulations, being relieved during an
- 15 operative procedure by another circulating nurse assigned to
- 16 continue the operative procedure shall not disqualify the nurse
- 17 from being a circulating nurse.
- 18 2. The data collected pursuant to subsection 1 shall be
- 19 made available to the public at least annually. A circulating
- 20 nurse shall assist the administration of the nurse's employing
- 21 facility in complying with this section.
- 22 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 23 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 24 EXPLANATION
- 25 This bill requires the collection and public reporting
- 26 of patient safety data regarding hospitals' and outpatient
- 27 surgical facilities' use of a registered nurse in the role of
- 28 a circulator that is present to assure quality care of the
- 29 patient during surgery.
