## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to permits to carry weapons and annual permits
- 2 to acquire pistols and revolvers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 724.4C, Code 2011, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 724.4C Possession or carrying of firearms while under the 4 influence Permit to carry validity.
- 5 A permit issued under this chapter is invalid if the person
- 6 to whom the permit is issued is or does any of the following:
- 7 <u>1.</u> is Is in an intoxicated condition as provided in section
- 8 321J.2, subsection 1.
- 9 2. Enters an establishment where alcoholic liquor, wine, or
- 10 beer is sold or consumed under authority of a liquor control
- 11 license, wine permit, or beer permit.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 724.9, subsection 2, unnumbered paragraph
- 13 1, Code 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 Evidence of qualification under this section subsection 1
- 15 may be documented by any of the following:
- 16 Sec. 3. Section 724.9, Code 2011, is amended by adding the
- 17 following new subsections:
- 18 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. In addition to the firearm safety
- 19 requirement in subsection 1, an applicant for a permit to
- 20 carry weapons shall qualify on a firing range under the
- 21 supervision of an instructor certified by the national rifle
- 22 association or the department of public safety or another
- 23 state's department of public safety, state police department,
- 24 or similar certifying body.
- 25 NEW SUBSECTION. 2B. Firearm training courses offered
- 26 through the internet do not satisfy the training requirements
- 27 set forth in this section.
- 28 Sec. 4. Section 724.11, subsection 1, Code 2011, is amended
- 29 to read as follows:
- 30 l. Applications for permits to carry weapons shall be made
- 31 to the sheriff of the county in which the applicant resides.
- 32 Applications for professional permits to carry weapons for
- 33 persons who are nonresidents of the state, or whose need to
- 34 go armed arises out of employment by the state, shall be made
- 35 to the commissioner of public safety. In either case, the

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- 1 sheriff or commissioner, before issuing the permit, shall
- 2 determine that the requirements of sections 724.6 to 724.10
- 3 have been satisfied. However, for An applicant for renewal of
- 4 a permit the shall also satisfy, within the twelve-month period
- 5 prior to the expiration of the applicant's current permit, the
- 6 training program and qualification requirements in section
- 7 724.9, subsection 1, shall apply or the renewal applicant may
- 8 choose to qualify on a firing range under the supervision of an
- 9 instructor certified by the national rifle association or the
- 10 department of public safety or another state's department of
- 11 public safety, state police department, or similar certifying
- 12 body. Such training or qualification must occur within the
- 13 twelve-month period prior to the expiration of the applicant's
- 14 current permit.
- 15 Sec. 5. Section 724.21A, subsection 4, Code 2011, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 4. Upon conclusion of the hearing, the administrative law
- 18 judge shall order that the denial, suspension, or revocation of
- 19 the permit be either rescinded or sustained. An unsuccessful
- 20 applicant or permit holder shall pay the costs associated
- 21 with the administrative appeal. An applicant, permit holder,
- 22 or issuing officer aggrieved by the final judgment of the
- 23 administrative law judge shall have the right to judicial
- 24 review in accordance with the terms of the Iowa administrative
- 25 procedure Act, chapter 17A.
- 26 EXPLANATION
- 27 This bill relates to permits to carry weapons and annual
- 28 permits to acquire pistols and revolvers.
- 29 The bill provides that a permit to carry weapons issued under
- 30 Code chapter 724 is invalid if the person to whom the permit is
- 31 issued enters an establishment where alcoholic liquor, wine, or
- 32 beer is sold and consumed under authority of a liquor control
- 33 license, wine permit, or beer permit.
- 34 The bill amends current firearm training requirements an
- 35 applicant for a permit to carry weapons must satisfy to be

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- 1 issued a permit to carry weapons under Code chapter 724 to
- 2 include the requirement that such applicant qualify on a firing
- 3 range under the supervision of an instructor certified by the
- 4 national rifle association or the department of public safety
- 5 or another state's department of public safety, state police
- 6 department, or similar certifying body. This requirement
- 7 applies to both new applicants and renewal applicants. The
- 8 bill specifies that internet firearm training courses do not
- 9 satisfy the firearm training requirements in Code section  $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right) ^{2}$
- 10 724.9.
- 11 The bill requires an unsuccessful applicant or permit holder
- 12 who appeals a denial of an application for or the suspension or
- 13 revocation of a permit to carry weapons or an annual permit to
- 14 acquire pistols or revolvers to pay the costs associated with
- 15 the administrative appeal.
