A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to social work, including the licensure of
- 2 social workers and the creation of a licensed social worker
- 3 loan repayment program and a revolving fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 154C.1, Code 2011, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. "Social worker" means a person who
- 4 holds a current license under this chapter or has received a
- 5 baccalaureate, master's, or doctoral degree in social work from
- 6 an accredited school of social work approved by the council on
- 7 social work education.
- 8 Sec. 2. Section 154C.2, Code 2011, is amended by striking
- 9 the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 10 154C.2 License required use of title.
- 11 l. A person shall not engage in the practice of social work
- 12 unless such person meets one of the following requirements:
- a. Has received a baccalaureate, master's, or doctoral
- 14 degree in social work from an accredited school of social work
- 15 approved by the council on social work education.
- 16 b. Holds a current social worker license pursuant to section
- 17 154C.3.
- 18 2. A government entity, public or private agency, or other
- 19 entity shall not use the title "social worker" or any form
- 20 of the title, including but not limited to the abbreviations
- 21 "S.W.", "B.S.W.", "M.S.W.", "D.S.W.", "L.B.S.W.", "L.M.S.W.",
- 22 or "L.I.S.W.", for volunteer or employment positions or within
- 23 contracts for services, documents, manuals, or reference
- 24 materials unless the volunteers or employees in those positions
- 25 are licensed social workers as set forth in this chapter.
- Sec. 3. Section 154C.3, subsection 1, Code 2011, is amended
- 27 to read as follows:
- 28 l. License requirements. An applicant for a license as a
- 29 bachelor social worker, master social worker, or independent
- 30 social worker shall meet the following requirements in addition
- 31 to paying all fees required by the board:
- 32 a. Bachelor social worker. An applicant for a license as a
- 33 bachelor social worker shall present evidence satisfactory to
- 34 the board that the applicant:
- 35 (1) Possesses a bachelor's degree in social work from an

1 accredited college or university school of social work approved 2 by the board council on social work education.

- 3 (2) Has passed an examination given by the board.
- 4 (3) Will conduct all professional activities as a bachelor
- 5 social worker in accordance with standards for professional
- 6 conduct established by the board.
- 7 b. Master social worker. An applicant for a license as a
- 8 master social worker shall present evidence satisfactory to the
- 9 board that the applicant:
- 10 (1) Possesses a master's or doctoral degree in social work
- 11 from an accredited college or university school of social work
- 12 approved by the board council on social work education.
- 13 (2) Has passed an examination given by the board.
- 14 (3) Will conduct all professional activities as a master
- 15 social worker in accordance with standards for professional
- 16 conduct established by the board.
- 17 c. Independent social worker. An applicant for a license
- 18 as an independent social worker shall present evidence
- 19 satisfactory to the board that the applicant:
- 20 (1) Possesses a master's or doctoral degree in social work
- 21 from an accredited college or university school of social work
- 22 approved by the board council on social work education.
- 23 (2) Has passed an examination given by the board.
- 24 (3) Will conduct all professional activities as a social
- 25 worker in accordance with standards for professional conduct
- 26 established by the board.
- 27 (4) Has engaged in the practice of social work, under
- 28 supervision, for at least two years as a full-time employee or
- 29 for four thousand hours prior to taking the examination given
- 30 by the board.
- 31 (5) (a) Supervision shall be provided in any of the
- 32 following manners:
- 33 (i) By a social worker licensed at least at the level of the
- 34 social worker being supervised and qualified under this section
- 35 to practice without supervision.

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- 1 (ii) By another qualified professional, if the board
- 2 determines that supervision by a social worker as defined
- 3 in subparagraph subdivision (i) is unobtainable or in other
- 4 situations considered appropriate by the board.
- 5 (b) Additional standards for supervision shall be
- 6 determined by the board.
- 7 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 261.113 Licensed social worker loan
- 8 repayment program.
- 9 1. A licensed social worker loan repayment program is
- 10 established, to be administered by the college student aid
- ll commission for the purpose of increasing the number of social
- 12 workers serving in critical human service areas. For purposes
- 13 of this section, "critical human service area" includes but
- 14 is not limited to an area of the state with a shortage of
- 15 social workers providing health, mental health, substance
- 16 abuse, aging, HIV/AIDS, victim, or child welfare services,
- 17 or communities with multilingual needs. These areas shall
- 18 be designated by the college student aid commission, in
- 19 consultation with a committee comprised of one representative
- 20 each from the commission, the department of public health, and
- 21 the department of human services.
- 22 2. The contract for the loan repayment shall stipulate the
- 23 time period the licensed social worker shall practice in a
- 24 critical human service area. In addition, the contract shall
- 25 stipulate that the licensed social worker repay any funds paid
- 26 on the person's loan by the commission if the person fails to
- 27 practice in a critical human service area for the required
- 28 period of time.
- 29 Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. 261.114 Licensed social worker loan
- 30 repayment revolving fund.
- 31 1. A licensed social worker loan repayment revolving fund
- 32 is created in the state treasury as a separate fund under
- 33 the control of the commission. The commission shall deposit
- 34 payments made by program participants under section 261.113,
- 35 subsection 2, moneys appropriated for purposes of the licensed

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- 1 social worker loan repayment program, and any other available
- 2 funds into the loan repayment revolving fund. Moneys in the
- 3 fund shall be used for purposes of the licensed social worker
- 4 loan repayment program. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys
- 5 deposited in the fund shall not revert to any fund of the state
- 6 at the end of any fiscal year but shall remain in the fund and
- 7 be continuously available for the program.
- Notwithstanding section 12C.7, subsection 2, interest
- 9 or earnings on moneys deposited in the fund shall be credited
- 10 to the fund.
- 11 3. a. The annual amount of loan repayment is six thousand
- 12 five hundred dollars for individuals who have provided
- 13 full-time social work services in a critical human service
- 14 area in the year prior to such application, provided that
- 15 no recipient shall receive loan repayment that exceeds the
- 16 total remaining balance of the student loan debt and that
- 17 no recipient shall receive cumulative awards in excess of
- 18 twenty-five thousand dollars.
- 19 b. Awards shall be within the amounts appropriated for such
- 20 purpose and based on availability of funds.
- 21 4. Loan repayment awards shall be made annually to
- 22 applicants in the following order of priority:
- 23 a. First priority is given to applicants who have received
- 24 payment of an award pursuant to this section in a prior year
- 25 and who have provided social work services in a critical human
- 26 service area in the year prior to such application.
- 27 b. Second priority is given to applicants who have not
- 28 received payment of an award pursuant to this section in
- 29 a prior year and who have provided social work services
- 30 in a critical human service area in the year prior to such
- 31 application.
- c. Third priority is given to applicants who are
- 33 economically disadvantaged, as defined by the commission.
- 34 5. The commission shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A
- 35 to administer this section.

1 EXPLANATION

- 2 This bill provides that only a person who is a licensed
- 3 social worker and has received a baccalaureate, master's,
- 4 or doctoral degree in social work from an accredited school
- 5 approved by the council on social work education may use the
- 6 title "social worker" or any form or abbreviation of the title.
- 7 The bill creates a licensed social worker loan repayment
- 8 program administered by the college student aid commission.
- 9 Applicants for the program must enter into an agreement with
- 10 the commission, agreeing to work for a specific period of time
- ll in a "critical human service area", defined as a geographic
- 12 area in Iowa with a shortage of social workers in health,
- 13 mental health, substance abuse, aging, HIV/AIDS, victim, or
- 14 child welfare concerns, or communities with multilingual needs.
- 15 The program provides a specific annual benefit, up to
- 16 \$6,500, for licensed social workers who have worked in a
- 17 critical human service area in the previous year. No recipient
- 18 shall receive loan repayment that exceeds the total remaining
- 19 balance of the student loan debt and no recipient shall receive
- 20 cumulative awards in excess of \$25,000.
- 21 The program is funded by a special revolving fund in
- 22 the state treasury, controlled by the college student aid
- 23 commission. The fund consists of moneys appropriated for
- 24 purposes of the program, repayments by participants who fail
- 25 to meet the service area requirements, and any other available
- 26 moneys. Moneys deposited in the fund do not revert to the
- 27 state at the end of any fiscal year but shall remain in the fund
- 28 and be continuously available for the program. Interest or
- 29 earnings on moneys deposited in the fund shall also be credited
- 30 to the fund.
