A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to and making appropriations to the judicial
- 2 branch.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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     Section 1. JUDICIAL BRANCH.
         There is appropriated from the general fund of the state
 3 to the judicial branch for the following fiscal years the
 4 following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
5 used for the purposes designated:
     a. For salaries of supreme court justices, appellate court
7 judges, district court judges, district associate judges,
8 judicial magistrates and staff, state court administrator,
9 clerk of the supreme court, district court administrators,
10 clerks of the district court, juvenile court officers, board of
11 law examiners and board of examiners of shorthand reporters and
12 judicial qualifications commission; receipt and disbursement
13 of child support payments; reimbursement of the auditor of
14 state for expenses incurred in completing audits of the offices
15 of the clerks of the district court during the fiscal years
16 beginning July 1, 2011, and July 1, 2012; and maintenance,
17 equipment, and miscellaneous purposes:

         The judicial branch, except for purposes of internal
28 processing, shall use the current state budget system, the
29 state payroll system, and the Iowa finance and accounting
30 system in administration of programs and payments for services,
31 and shall not duplicate the state payroll, accounting, and
32 budgeting systems.
         The judicial branch shall submit monthly financial
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35 department of management containing all appropriated accounts

34 statements to the legislative services agency and the

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1 in the same manner as provided in the monthly financial status

- 2 reports and personal services usage reports of the department
- 3 of administrative services. The monthly financial statements
- 4 shall include a comparison of the dollars and percentage
- 5 spent of budgeted versus actual revenues and expenditures on
- 6 a cumulative basis for full-time equivalent positions and
- 7 dollars.
- The judicial branch shall focus efforts upon the
- 9 collection of delinquent fines, penalties, court costs, fees,
- 10 surcharges, or similar amounts.
- 11 5. The judicial branch shall submit a semiannual update
- 12 to the legislative services agency specifying the amounts of
- 13 fines, surcharges, and court costs collected using the Iowa
- 14 court information system since the last report. The judicial
- 15 branch shall continue to facilitate the sharing of vital
- 16 sentencing and other information with other state departments
- 17 and governmental agencies involved in the criminal justice
- 18 system through the Iowa court information system.
- 19 6. a. The judicial branch shall provide a report to the
- 20 general assembly by January 1, 2012, concerning the amounts
- 21 received and expended from the enhanced court collections
- 22 fund created in section 602.1304 and the court technology and
- 23 modernization fund created in section 602.8108, subsection
- 24 7, during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, and ending
- 25 June 30, 2011, and the plans for expenditures from each fund
- 26 during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, and ending
- 27 June 30, 2012. A copy of the report shall be provided to the
- 28 legislative services agency.
- 29 b. The judicial branch shall provide a report to the general
- 30 assembly by January 1, 2013, concerning the amounts received
- 31 and expended from the enhanced court collections fund created
- 32 in section 602.1304 and the court technology and modernization
- 33 fund created in section 602.8108, subsection 7, during the
- 34 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2012,
- 35 and the plans for expenditures from each fund during the fiscal

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1 year beginning July 1, 2012, and ending June 30, 2013. A copy

2 of the report shall be provided to the legislative services

- 3 agency.
- 4 7. The judicial branch is encouraged to purchase products
- 5 from Iowa state industries, as defined in section 904.802, when
- 6 purchases are required and the products are available from Iowa
- 7 state industries. The judicial branch shall obtain bids from
- 8 Iowa state industries for purchases of office furniture during
- 9 the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2011, and July 1, 2012,
- 10 exceeding \$5,000.
- 11 Sec. 2. CIVIL TRIALS LOCATION. Notwithstanding any
- 12 provision to the contrary, for the fiscal years beginning July
- 13 1, 2011, and July 1, 2012, if all parties in a case agree, a
- 14 civil trial including a jury trial may take place in a county
- 15 contiguous to the county with proper jurisdiction, even if the
- 16 contiguous county is located in an adjacent judicial district
- 17 or judicial election district. If the trial is moved pursuant
- 18 to this section, court personnel shall treat the case as if a
- 19 change of venue occurred. However, if a trial is moved to an
- 20 adjacent judicial district or judicial election district, the
- 21 judicial officers serving in the judicial district or judicial
- 22 election district receiving the case shall preside over the
- 23 case.
- 24 Sec. 3. TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT. Notwithstanding section
- 25 602.1509, for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2011, and July
- 26 1, 2012, a judicial officer may waive travel reimbursement for
- 27 any travel outside the judicial officer's county of residence
- 28 to conduct official judicial business.
- 29 Sec. 4. POSTING OF REPORTS IN ELECTRONIC FORMAT —
- 30 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES AGENCY. All reports or copies of reports
- 31 required to be provided by the judicial branch for fiscal years
- 32 beginning July 1, 2011, and July 1, 2012, to the legislative
- 33 services agency shall be provided in an electronic format.
- 34 The legislative services agency shall post the reports on its
- 35 internet website and shall notify by electronic means all the

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- 1 members of the joint appropriations subcommittee on the justice
- 2 system when a report is posted. Upon request, copies of the
- 3 reports may be mailed to members of the joint appropriations
- 4 subcommittee on the justice system.
- 5 Sec. 5. JUDICIAL OFFICER UNPAID LEAVE. Notwithstanding
- 6 the annual salary rates for judicial officers established
- 7 by 2008 Iowa Acts, chapter 1191, section 11, for the fiscal
- 8 years beginning July 1, 2011, and July 1, 2012, the supreme
- 9 court may by order place all judicial officers on unpaid leave
- 10 status on any day employees of the judicial branch are placed
- 11 on temporary layoff status. The biweekly pay of the judicial
- 12 officers shall be reduced accordingly for the pay period in
- 13 which the unpaid leave date occurred in the same manner as for
- 14 noncontract employees of the judicial branch. Through the
- 15 course of the two fiscal years, the judicial branch may use an
- 16 amount equal to the aggregate amount of salary reductions due
- 17 to the judicial officer unpaid leave days for any purpose other
- 18 than for judicial salaries.
- 19 Sec. 6. IOWA COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK. It is the intent
- 20 of the general assembly that the judicial branch utilize
- 21 the Iowa communications network or other secure electronic
- 22 communications in lieu of traveling for the fiscal years
- 23 beginning July 1, 2011, and July 1, 2012.
- 24 EXPLANATION
- 25 This bill appropriates from the general fund of the state
- 26 for FY 2011-2012 and FY 2012-2013 to the judicial branch for
- 27 salaries, maintenance, equipment, and miscellaneous purposes.
- 28 The bill appropriates \$3.7 million from the general fund of
- 29 the state for FY 2011-2012 to the revolving fund created in
- 30 Code section 602.1302 for jury and witness fees, mileage, costs
- 31 related to summoning jurors, fees for interpreters, and certain
- 32 attorney fee reimbursement. The bill also appropriates \$3.7
- 33 million from the general fund of the state to the revolving
- 34 fund for FY 2012-2013.
- 35 The bill provides for the two fiscal years that a civil trial

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- 1 including a jury trial may take place in a county contiguous
- 2 to the county with proper jurisdiction, even if the contiguous
- 3 county is located in an adjacent judicial district or judicial
- 4 election district, if all the parties in a case agree. If a
- 5 trial is moved to another county that is located in another
- 6 judicial district or judicial election district, the judicial
- 7 officers serving the judicial district or judicial election
- 8 district receiving the case shall preside over the case.
- 9 The bill permits a judicial officer to waive travel
- 10 reimbursement for any travel outside the judicial officer's
- 11 county of residence to conduct official business.
- 12 The bill allows a judicial officer to be placed on unpaid
- 13 leave, by order of the supreme court, for the fiscal years
- 14 beginning July 1, 2011, and July 1, 2012, on any day a court
- 15 employee is placed on temporary layoff status. The bill
- 16 provides that if a judicial officer is placed on unpaid leave,
- 17 the salary of the judicial officer shall be reduced accordingly
- 18 for the pay period in which the unpaid leave occurred. Through
- 19 the course of the two fiscal years, the bill provides that the
- 20 judicial branch may use an amount equal to the aggregate amount
- 21 of the salary reductions due to judicial officer unpaid leave
- 22 for any purpose other than judicial salaries.
- 23 The bill provides legislative intent that the judicial
- 24 branch utilize the Iowa communications network or other secure
- 25 electronic communications in lieu of traveling.
