- 3 The unit may prepare a notice of alleged paternity and

- 6 possible paternity or assertions of paternity including but not
- 7 limited to a government official relying on government records,
- 8 provides a written statement to the unit department of human
- 9 services certifying in accordance with section 622.1 that the
- 10 putative father is or may be the biological father of the child
- ll or children involved. The notice shall be accompanied by a
- 12 copy of the statement and served on the putative father in
- 13 accordance with rule of civil procedure 1.305. Service upon
- 14 the mother shall not constitute valid service upon the putative
- 15 father. The notice shall include or be accompanied by all of
- 16 the following:

17 EXPLANATION

- 18 This bill allows the use of a written statement certified
- 19 under penalty of perjury by a person with knowledge of the
- 20 circumstances of possible paternity or assertions of paternity,
- 21 including but not limited to a government official relying on
- 22 government records, to act as the basis for preparation by the
- 23 child support recovery unit of a notice of alleged paternity
- 24 and support debt to be served on the putative father in an
- 25 administrative establishment of paternity proceeding. Under
- 26 current law, the only basis for preparation of the notice is
- 27 the certified written statement of the mother of the child
- 28 provided to the child support recovery unit.
