## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the authority of cities to regulate and
- 2 restrict the occupancy of residential rental property.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 414.1, subsection 1, Code 2011, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- a. For the purpose of promoting the health, safety,
- 4 morals, or the general welfare of the community or for the
- 5 purpose of preserving historically significant areas of
- 6 the community, any city is hereby empowered to regulate and
- 7 restrict the height, number of stories, and size of buildings
- 8 and other structures, the percentage of lot that may be
- 9 occupied, the size of yards, courts, and other open spaces,
- 10 the density of population, the occupancy of residential rental
- 11 property on the basis of square footage, and the location and
- 12 use of buildings, structures, and land for trade, industry,
- 13 residence, or other purposes.
- 14 b. A city shall not adopt or enforce any regulation or
- 15 restriction related to the occupancy of residential rental
- 16 property that is based upon the existence of familial or
- 17 nonfamilial relationships between the occupants of such rental
- 18 property.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- 20 This bill relates to the authority of cities to regulate and
- 21 restrict the occupancy of residential rental property.
- 22 The bill provides that a city may regulate and restrict the
- 23 occupancy of residential rental property on the basis of square
- 24 footage. The bill also provides that a city shall not adopt or
- 25 enforce any regulation or restriction related to the occupancy
- 26 of residential rental property based upon the familial or
- 27 nonfamilial relationships of occupants.
