Section 236.5, subsection 1, unnumbered 2 paragraph 1, Code 2013, is amended to read as follows: Upon a finding that the defendant has engaged in domestic 3 4 abuse and that the defendant represents a credible threat to 5 the physical safety of the plaintiff: 6 EXPLANATION 7 This bill relates to the court's authority to grant a 8 protective order following an adjudication of domestic abuse. Current law allows the court to enter a civil protective 9 10 order, upon hearing, upon a finding by a preponderance of the 11 evidence that the defendant has engaged in domestic abuse. 12 Iowa Court Rule, Chapter 4 (form 2) provides that when the 13 court finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the 14 defendant was properly served, committed domestic abuse against 15 the protected party, and represents a credible threat to the 16 protected party, the court issues a protective order. The bill requires the court to find, by a preponderance of 17 18 the evidence, that the defendant represents a credible threat 19 to the physical safety of the plaintiff in order to grant a 20 protective order.
