## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act making certain students who open enroll to a school
- 2 district in a county contiguous to the school district of
- 3 residence eligible for transportation assistance.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 282.18, subsection 10, paragraph c, Code 2 2013, is amended to read as follows:

If the pupil meets the economic eligibility requirements C. 3 4 established by the department and state board of education, the 5 sending district is responsible for providing transportation 6 or paying the pro rata cost of the transportation to a parent 7 or guardian for transporting the pupil to and from a point on 8 a regular school bus route of a contiguous receiving district 9 that is contiguous to the sending district, or is located in 10 a county that is contiguous to the sending district, unless 11 the cost of providing transportation or the pro rata cost of 12 the transportation to a parent or guardian exceeds the average 13 transportation cost per pupil transported for the previous 14 school year in the district. If the cost exceeds the average 15 transportation cost per pupil transported for the previous 16 school year, the sending district shall only be responsible 17 for that average per pupil amount. A sending district which 18 provides transportation for a pupil to a contiguous receiving 19 district under this subsection may withhold, from the district 20 cost per pupil amount that is to be paid to the receiving 21 district, an amount which represents the average or pro rata 22 cost per pupil for transportation, whichever is less.

## EXPLANATION

23

This bill expands the responsibilities of a sending school district for transporting or paying for the costs of transporting pupils participating in open enrollment who meet the economic eligibility requirements established by the state board of education and the department of education. Currently, the sending district's responsibilities are only to transport or pay for such students who open enroll to a contiguous school district. The bill makes the sending district responsible for such students who open enroll to a district that is contiguous to the sending district or is located in a county that is contiguous to the sending district.
