- 1 Section 1. Section 256B.9, subsection 7, Code 2013, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 7. a. The costs of special education instructional programs
- 4 include the costs of purchase of transportation equipment
- 5 to meet the special needs of children requiring special
- 6 education with the approval of the director of the department
- 7 of education.
- 8 b. The department of education shall administer the costs of
- 9 special education instructional programs when contracted with a
- 10 private agency that provides residential treatment services to
- 11 meet the special needs of children requiring special education,
- 12 which costs include costs of general administration, health
- 13 service, attendance officers, plant operation, and plant
- 14 maintenance; regular and special instructional costs; overhead
- 15 costs; and the costs of purchase of equipment, transportation,
- 16 and insurance.
- 17 c. The state board of education shall adopt rules under
- 18 chapter 17A for the purchase of transportation equipment
- 19 pursuant to administer this section.
- 20 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 21 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 22 Sec. 3. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
- 23 retroactively to July 1, 2012.
- 24 EXPLANATION
- 25 This bill directs the department of education to administer
- 26 the costs of special education instructional programs when
- 27 contracted with a private agency that provides residential
- 28 treatment services to meet the special needs of children
- 29 requiring special education. Such costs include costs of
- 30 general administration, health service, attendance officers,
- 31 plant operation, and plant maintenance; regular and special
- 32 instructional costs; overhead costs; and the costs of purchase
- 33 of equipment, transportation, and insurance.
- 34 The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies
- 35 retroactively to July 1, 2012.
