- 5 person has not paid all fees, fines, and civil penalties
- 6 related to the violation.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 907.14, subsection 1, Code 2013, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 1. Upon Except as provided in section 907.3, subsection 1,
- 10 paragraph "n", upon the entry of a deferred judgment pursuant to
- 11 section 907.3, a defendant shall be assessed a civil penalty
- 12 of an amount not less than the amount of any criminal fine
- 13 authorized by law for the offense under section 902.9 or
- 14 section 903.1.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- 16 This bill relates to the entry of a deferred judgment for
- 17 certain alcohol violations by persons under legal age.
- 18 The bill provides that a deferred judgment is not available
- 19 for a person under legal age who commits a violation of Code
- 20 section 123.46 (public intoxication) or Code section 123.47
- 21 (minor in possession of alcohol) until the person has paid all
- 22 fees, fines, and civil penalties. The bill makes a conforming
- 23 change to current law which provides that upon the entry of a
- 24 deferred judgment pursuant to Code section 907.3, a defendant
- 25 shall be assessed a civil penalty.
- Under Code section 123.3, "legal age" means 21 years of age
- 27 or older.
