# A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing an education remediation council in the
- 2 department of education.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **256.27 Education remediation** 2 council.
- An education remediation council is established within
- 4 the department. The council shall consist of eight members
- 5 appointed as follows:
- 6 a. One member representing the community colleges appointed
- 7 by the president of the Iowa association of community college
- 8 presidents.
- 9 b. One member representing the accredited private
- 10 institutions appointed by the president of the Iowa association
- 11 of independent colleges and universities.
- 12 c. One member representing the institutions of higher
- 13 education governed by the state board of regents appointed by
- 14 the president of the state board of regents.
- 15 d. One member representing the practitioner preparation
- 16 programs at institutions of higher education governed by the
- 17 state board of regents appointed by the president of the state
- 18 board of regents.
- 19 e. One member representing school districts appointed by the
- 20 president of the Iowa association of school boards.
- 21 f. One member representing accredited nonpublic schools
- 22 appointed by the director.
- 23 q. One member representing the department appointed by the
- 24 director.
- 25 h. One member representing the area education agencies
- 26 appointed by the area education agency administrators.
- 27 2. Council members shall serve three-year terms beginning
- 28 and ending as provided in section 69.19, and appointments shall
- 29 comply with sections 69.16, 69.16A, and 69.16C. Vacancies on
- 30 the council shall be filled in the same manner as the original
- 31 appointment. A person appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve
- 32 only for the unexpired portion of the term.
- 33 3. The member representing the department shall convene the
- 34 initial meeting. The council shall elect one of its members as
- 35 chairperson. The council shall meet at least quarterly, and at

- 1 any time on the call of the chairperson.
- 2 4. The department shall provide staffing services for the 3 council.
- 4 5. a. Prior to the initial meeting of the council, the
- 5 member representing the community colleges shall convene
- 6 a meeting of members appointed pursuant to subsection 1,
- 7 paragraphs "a" through "d" to define "remediation" for purposes
- 8 of the council and outline the skills and expectations for
- 9 postsecondary level attendance. The definitions and outline
- 10 shall be distributed and discussed at the initial council
- 11 meeting.
- 12 b. The council shall identify measures to help students
- 13 transition from the secondary to the postsecondary level,
- 14 limit the cost of remediation, define and standardize the
- 15 skill sets that determine the need for remediation, and create
- 16 effective partnerships between secondary schools and higher
- 17 education institutions. For the fiscal year beginning July
- 18 1, 2013, the council shall focus on but not be limited to
- 19 mathematics and English remediation measures. The council
- 20 shall review activities and services designed to align school
- 21 district curricula with core postsecondary level requirements
- 22 and decrease the need for remedial coursework at the secondary
- 23 school grade level through grade sixteen. The council shall
- 24 develop strategies to strengthen grade nine through grade
- 25 sixteen standards, competencies, assessment systems, and the
- 26 professional development of teachers.
- 27 6. The council shall submit its findings and
- 28 recommendations in a report to the state board of education
- 29 and the general assembly by November 15 annually. The state
- 30 board and department shall use the findings and recommendations
- 31 to strengthen the common core curriculum and core content
- 32 standards.
- 33 EXPLANATION
- 34 This bill establishes an education remediation council
- 35 within the department of education to identify measures to help

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  2 level, limit the cost of remediation, define and standardize
  3 the skill sets that determine the need for remediation, and
- 4 create effective partnerships between secondary schools and
- 5 higher education institutions. For the fiscal year beginning
- 6 July 1, 2013, the council shall focus on but not be limited
- 7 to mathematics and English remediation measures. The council
- 8 must review activities and services designed to align school
- 9 district curricula with core postsecondary level requirements
- 10 and decrease the need for remedial coursework at the secondary
- 11 school grade level through grade 16. The council shall develop
- 12 strategies to strengthen grade 9-16 standards, competencies,
- 13 assessment systems, and the professional development of
- 14 teachers.
- 15 The council consists of eight members appointed to
- 16 represent community colleges, accredited private postsecondary
- 17 institutions, regents universities, practitioner preparation
- 18 programs at the regents universities, school districts,
- 19 accredited nonpublic schools, the department, and area
- 20 education agencies.
- 21 The member representing the department shall convene
- 22 the initial meeting, at which the council shall elect one
- 23 of its members as chairperson. The council shall meet
- 24 at least quarterly, and at any time on the call of the
- 25 chairperson. Prior to the initial meeting, the member
- 26 representing the community colleges shall convene a meeting
- 27 of members representing the community colleges, accredited
- 28 private postsecondary institutions, regents universities, and
- 29 practitioner preparation programs at the regents universities
- 30 to define "remediation" for purposes of the council and outline
- 31 the skills and expectations for postsecondary level attendance.
- 32 The definitions and outline shall be distributed and discussed
- 33 at the initial council meeting.
- 34 The department shall provide staffing services for the
- 35 council.

- 1 The council shall submit its findings and recommendations
- 2 in a report to the state board of education and the general
- 3 assembly by November 15 annually. The state board and
- 4 the department of education must use the findings and
- 5 recommendations to strengthen the common core curriculum and
- 6 core content standards.
