## A BILL FOR

1 An Act to provide that peace officers and retired peace 2 officers qualify as classroom driver education instructors. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 272.31, Code 2013, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 3A. The board shall issue a classroom driver education instructor authorization for purposes of section 321.178 to a person who completes a training program that meets the standards set by the board, who complies with rules adopted pursuant to subsection 4 , and who is either a peace officer as defined in section 801.4 , subsection ll, or is retired under chapter 97A or 4ll, or section 97B.49B or 97B.49C, after service as a peace officer as defined in section 801.4, subsection ll. The training program shall include but not be limited to a minimum of fifteen contact hours in a program consisting of instruction relating to classroom management, strategies for learning, diversity, and ethics.

Sec. 2. Section 321.178 , subsection l, paragraph b, subparagraph (1), Code 2013, is amended to read as follows:
(1) To be qualified as a classroom driver education instructor, a person shall have-satisfied the educational requiremento for a teaching meet one of the following requirements:
(a) Hold a valid teacher's license at the elementary or secondary level and hold a valid license an endorsement to teach driver education in the public schools of this state issued under chapter 272.
(b) Be a peace officer as defined in section 801.4, subsection ll, or, be retired under chapter 97A or 4ll, or section 97B.49B or 97B.49C, after service as a peace officer as defined in section 801.4 , subsection 11 , and meet the requirements of section 272.31 , subsection $3 A$. EXPLANATION

This bill permits a person who is a peace officer or a retired peace officer to be qualified as a classroom driver education instructor if the person also meets the board of educational examiner's requirements for a classroom driver education instructor authorization. Currently, only persons

holding a teaching license with an endorsement to teach driver 2 education may qualify to be a classroom driver education 3 instructor.

4 The bill directs the board of educational examiners to
5 issue a classroom driver education instructor authorization
6 to a person who completes a training program that meets the standards set by the board and who is either a peace officer or 8 a retired peace officer. The training program shall include
9 but not be limited to a minimum of 15 contact hours in a program
10 consisting of instruction relating to classroom management,
11 strategies for learning, diversity, and ethics.
12 The term "peace officer" is currently defined in Code 13 section 801.4 , subsection ll, to include sheriffs, deputy 14 sheriffs, marshals and police officers of cities, peace officer 15 members of the department of public safety, parole officers, 16 probation officers, special security officers employed by 17 regents institutions, conservation officers, employees of 18 the department of transportation or of an aviation authority 19 designated as "peace officers", and such persons as may be 20 otherwise so designated by law.
