A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to a foreign language requirement at the
- 2 elementary school level and including effective date
- 3 provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 256.11, subsection 3, Code 2013, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 3. The following areas shall be taught in grades one through
- 4 six: English-language arts, social studies, mathematics,
- 5 science, health, age-appropriate and research-based human
- 6 growth and development, physical education, traffic safety,
- 7 music, and visual art. The health curriculum shall include the
- 8 characteristics of communicable diseases including acquired
- 9 immune deficiency syndrome. At least one foreign language
- 10 shall be taught in grades one through six in school districts.
- 11 The state board as part of accreditation standards shall adopt
- 12 curriculum definitions for implementing the elementary program.
- 13 Sec. 2. FOREIGN LANGUAGE FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS SCHOOL
- 14 DISTRICT PLAN. The board of directors of each school district
- 15 shall develop and implement a plan to teach at least one
- 16 foreign language in grades one through six by the school year
- 17 beginning July 1, 2015.
- 18 Sec. 3. STATE MANDATE FUNDING SPECIFIED. In accordance
- 19 with section 25B.2, subsection 3, the state cost of requiring
- 20 compliance with any state mandate included in this Act shall
- 21 be paid by a school district from state school foundation aid
- 22 received by the school district under section 257.16. This
- 23 specification of the payment of the state cost shall be deemed
- 24 to meet all of the state funding-related requirements of
- 25 section 25B.2, subsection 3, and no additional state funding
- 26 shall be necessary for the full implementation of this Act
- 27 by and enforcement of this Act against all affected school
- 28 districts.
- 29 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. The following provision or
- 30 provisions of this Act take effect July 1, 2015:
- The section of this Act amending section 256.11,
- 32 subsection 3.
- 33 EXPLANATION
- 34 This bill requires school districts to develop and implement
- 35 a plan to teach at least one foreign language in grades one

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- 1 through six by the school year beginning July 1, 2015. The
- 2 provision that amends the educational standards to require
- 3 school districts to teach at least one foreign language in
- 4 grades one through six takes effect July 1, 2015.
- 5 The bill may include a state mandate as defined in Code
- 6 section 25B.3. The bill requires that the state cost of
- 7 any state mandate included in the bill be paid by a school
- 8 district from state school foundation aid received by the
- 9 school district under Code section 257.16. The specification
- 10 is deemed to constitute state compliance with any state mandate
- 11 funding-related requirements of Code section 25B.2. The
- 12 inclusion of this specification is intended to reinstate the
- 13 requirement of political subdivisions to comply with any state
- 14 mandates included in the bill.
