HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 113 BY KAJTAZOVIC

1 A Resolution commemorating July 11th as the anniversary 2 of the Srebrenica genocide. 3 WHEREAS, on July 11, 1995, the eastern Bosnian town 4 of Srebrenica fell to the Bosnian Serb forces; and 5 WHEREAS, during the next several days of carnage 6 more than 8,000 Muslim men and boys were summarily 7 executed by Bosnian Serb forces; and WHEREAS, approximately 20 percent of Srebrenica's 8 9 total population at the time, at least 7,000 and 10 perhaps thousands more, was either executed or 11 otherwise killed; and WHEREAS, in spite of the enormous efforts made 12 13 to date to discover and exhume mass and individual 14 graves and identify the bodies of the victims, 15 the searches conducted up until now do not offer a 16 complete reconstruction of the events in and around 17 Srebrenica; and WHEREAS, the massacre at Srebrenica was among the 18 19 worst of many horrible atrocities to occur in the 20 conflict in Bosnia and Herzegovina, which ultimately 21 led to the displacement of more than 2,000,000 people, 22 with an estimated 200,000 killed; NOW THEREFORE, 23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, 24 That the House of Representatives commemorates July 25 llth in remembrance of the Srebrenica genocide and 26 urges all Iowans to consider the horror of genocide 27 and to actively support efforts to eliminate this most 28 terrible of crimes.
