1 Section 1. PARENTAL OBLIGATION PILOT PROGRAM

2 APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the general fund of 3 the state to the department of human services for the fiscal 4 year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, the 5 following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be 6 used for the purposes designated:

7 To fund the expansion of an existing unfunded pilot project, 8 as defined in 441 IAC 100.1, relating to parental obligations, 9 in which the child support recovery unit participates, to 10 support the efforts of a nonprofit organization committed to 11 strengthening the community through youth development, healthy 12 living, and social responsibility in a county with a population 13 over 350,000:

15 The funds appropriated in this section shall be used by 16 the recipient organization to develop a larger community 17 effort, through public and private partnerships, to support 18 a broad-based fatherhood initiative that promotes payment of 19 child support obligations, improved family relationships, and 20 full-time employment.

EXPLANATION

This bill appropriates \$40,000 from the general fund of the 22 23 state for fiscal year 2013-2014, to the department of human 24 services to fund the expansion of an existing unfunded parental 25 obligations pilot project, in which the child support recovery 26 unit (CSRU) participates, and which is supported by the efforts 27 of a nonprofit organization committed to strengthening the 28 community through youth development, healthy living, and social 29 responsibility in a county with a population over 350,000. 30 The CSRU participates in and develops parental obligations 31 pilot projects pursuant to 441 IAC ch. 100 to develop new ways 32 to assist parents in overcoming the barriers which interfere 33 with fulfilling their obligations to their children. Parental 34 obligations under the projects include emotional and personal 35 involvement of the parents beyond simply meeting financial

1 obligations. An "unfunded pilot project" is a project in which 2 CSRU participates which is funded totally by an entity other 3 than CSRU, but which may use incentives offered under 441 IAC 4 ch. 100, such as establishment or modification of support 5 obligations that deviate from the child support guidelines. 6 The funds appropriated in the bill are to be used by 7 the recipient organization to develop a larger community 8 effort, through public and private partnerships, to support 9 a broad-based fatherhood initiative that promotes payment of 10 child support obligations, improved family relationships, and 11 full-time employment.
