## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to game birds only hunting preserves.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.F. 141

- 1 Section 1. Section 484B.4, subsection 1, Code 2013, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. A person who owns or controls by lease or otherwise
- 4 for five or more years, a contiguous tract of land having an
- 5 area of not less than three hundred twenty acres, or in the
- 6 case of a hunting preserve for game birds only, an area of not
- 7 less than forty acres, and who desires to establish a hunting
- 8 preserve, to propagate and sell game birds and their young
- 9 or unhatched eggs, and shoot game birds and ungulates on the
- 10 land, under this chapter or the rules of the commission, shall
- 11 make application to the department for an operator's license.
- 12 The application shall be made under oath of the applicant or
- 13 under oath of one of its principal officers if the applicant
- 14 is an association or corporation. Under the authority of this
- 15 license, any property or facilities to be used for propagating,
- 16 holding, processing, or pasturing of game birds or ungulates
- 17 shall not be required to be contained within the contiguous
- 18 land area used for hunting purposes. An application for a
- 19 hunting preserve for game birds only, with an area from forty
- 20 acres up to three hundred twenty acres in size, shall be
- 21 accompanied by a game bird habitat plan which has been approved
- 22 by the department. The application shall be accompanied by an
- 23 operator's license fee of two hundred dollars.
- 24 Sec. 2. Section 484B.4, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
- 25 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- 26 a. The proposed hunting preserve contains at least three
- 27 hundred twenty acres, or in the case of a hunting preserve for
- 28 game birds only, at least forty acres, but not more than two
- 29 thousand five hundred sixty acres.
- 30 Sec. 3. Section 484B.4, subsection 2, Code 2013, is amended
- 31 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 32 NEW PARAGRAPH. Ob. A proposed hunting preserve for game
- 33 birds only with an area from forty acres up to three hundred
- 34 twenty acres in size is accompanied by a game bird habitat
- 35 plan which has been approved by the department, and upon

- 1 inspection of the proposed hunting preserve, the department is 2 satisfied with implementation of the plan.
- 3 EXPLANATION
- 4 This bill relates to the issuance of a license to operate a
- 5 hunting preserve that is for game birds only. The bill reduces
- 6 the minimum number of contiguous acres that are required for
- 7 the establishment of a hunting preserve from 320 acres to 40
- 8 acres if the preserve is for game birds only. However, an
- 9 application for a license to operate such a hunting preserve
- 10 with an area from 40 acres up to 320 acres must be accompanied
- 11 by a game bird habitat plan approved by the department of
- 12 natural resources and upon inspection of the proposed preserve,
- 13 the department must be satisfied with implementation of the
- 14 plan before an operator's license can be issued.
