3	EXPLANATION
4	The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
5	the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
6	Current law prohibits a person from using a hand-held
7	electronic communication device to write, read, or send a
8	text message while driving a motor vehicle. A violation is
9	punishable by a scheduled fine of \$30, but it is not considered
LO	a moving violation. In addition, the prohibition against
L1	texting while driving is only enforceable as a secondary
L 2	action when the motor vehicle has been stopped for a suspected
L3	violation of another law. Under this bill, a peace officer is
L 4	authorized to stop a person suspected of texting while driving,
L 5	regardless of whether a violation of another law has occurred.
