A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act making an appropriation to support soil and water
- 2 conservation by the department of agriculture and land
- 3 stewardship.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 400

- Section 1. SOIL CONSERVATION APPROPRIATION.
- 2 There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
- 3 department of agriculture and land stewardship for the fiscal
- 4 year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, the
- 5 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
- 6 used for the purposes designated:
- 7 l. For use by the department to support soil and water
- 8 conservation district commissioners:
- 9 \$ 7,000,000
- 10 2. The department shall allocate the amount of the
- 11 appropriation made in subsection 1 to soil and water
- 12 conservation district commissioners in the same manner that the
- 13 department allocated moneys appropriated from the environment
- 14 first fund to support soil and water conservation district
- 15 commissioners pursuant to 2012 Iowa Acts, chapter 1135, section
- 16 18, subsection 6.
- 3. The entire amount of the appropriation made in subsection
- 18 1 shall be used to support soil conservation practices
- 19 established on a cost-share basis as provided in chapter 161A.
- 20 The soil and water conservation district commissioners shall
- 21 award the moneys allocated by the department to persons who
- 22 submitted applications to the commissioners on or after July
- 23 1, 2012, if such applications are pending approval on the
- 24 effective date of this Act, and the commissioners subsequently
- 25 approve the applications.
- 4. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated to
- 27 the department pursuant to this section are not subject to
- 28 reversion to the general fund of the state.
- 29 EXPLANATION
- 30 This bill appropriates moneys from the general fund
- 31 of the state to the department of agriculture and land
- 32 stewardship for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and
- 33 ending June 30, 2014, for use by soil and water conservation
- 34 district commissioners to support soil conservation practices
- 35 established on a cost-share basis. The moneys are to finance

- 1 pending applications for the establishment of such practices
- 2 submitted on or after July 1, 2012. The appropriated moneys
- 3 are not subject to reversion as ordinarily provided under Code
- 4 section 8.33.
