A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act making a transfer of revenue to the road use tax fund and
- 2 including effective date provisions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. TRANSFER TO ROAD USE TAX FUND.
- 2 l. There is transferred from the general fund of the state
- 3 to the road use tax fund for the fiscal year beginning July
- 4 1, 2012, and ending June 30, 2013, the following amount, or
- 5 so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes
- 6 designated:
- 7 For allocation or appropriation from the road use tax fund
- 8 in accordance with law:
- 9 \$ 50,000,000
- 10 2. The transfer made in this section is for the purpose of
- 11 reducing the need to increase taxes and fees on the citizens
- 12 of this state in order to meet transportation needs. It is
- 13 the intent of the general assembly to make transfers for the
- 14 same purpose in future fiscal years when there are state fund
- 15 balances available to do so.
- 16 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 17 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 18 EXPLANATION
- 19 This bill makes a transfer of revenue to the road use tax
- 20 fund. The bill states that the transfer is for the purpose of
- 21 reducing the need to increase taxes and fees on the citizens of
- 22 this state in order to meet transportation needs.
- 23 The moneys credited to the road use tax fund are subject
- 24 to standing and other appropriations and are allocated by
- 25 formula to the primary road fund, the secondary road fund of
- 26 the counties, the farm-to-market road fund, and the street
- 27 construction fund of the cities, and to related funds for
- 28 expenditure.
- 29 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
