A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act exempting internet protocol-enabled service from the
- 2 regulatory authority of the utilities board of the utilities
- 3 division of the department of commerce.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 476.1, Code 2013, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 5A. a. Notwithstanding any other provision
- 4 to the contrary, the board shall not by rule, order, or other
- 5 means directly or indirectly regulate the entry, rates, terms,
- 6 or conditions for internet protocol-enabled service. For the
- 7 purposes of this subsection, "internet protocol-enabled service"
- 8 means any service, capability, functionality, or application
- 9 that uses internet protocol or any successor protocol and
- 10 enables an end user to send or receive voice, data, or video
- 11 communication in internet protocol format or a successor
- 12 format.
- 13 b. This subsection shall not be construed to limit or impact
- 14 the enforcement or implementation of such requirements as are
- 15 otherwise provided for by federal law or the E911 service
- 16 provisions of chapter 34A and the collection or imposition of
- 17 E911 surcharges or fees. This subsection shall also not be
- 18 construed to modify or affect the application or enforcement
- 19 of a law or rule that may apply generally to the conduct of
- 20 business in this state, including but not limited to consumer
- 21 protection and unfair or deceptive trade practice laws and
- 22 rules.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 This bill exempts internet protocol-enabled service from
- 25 the regulatory authority of the Iowa utilities board. The
- 26 bill defines "internet protocol-enabled service" to mean any
- 27 service, capability, functionality, or application that uses
- 28 internet protocol or any successor protocol and enables an end
- 29 user to send or receive voice, data, or video communication in
- 30 internet protocol format or a successor format.
- 31 The bill states that, notwithstanding any other provision to
- 32 the contrary, the Iowa utilities board may not by rule, order,
- 33 or other means directly or indirectly regulate the entry,
- 34 rates, terms, or conditions for internet protocol-enabled
- 35 service. The bill specifies that this provision shall

- 1 not be interpreted to limit or impact the enforcement or
- 2 implementation of federal requirements or the E911 service
- 3 provisions of Code chapter 34A and the collection or imposition
- 4 of E911 surcharges or fees. The bill additionally specifies
- 5 that its provisions shall not be interpreted to modify or
- 6 affect the application or enforcement of a law or rule that may
- 7 apply generally to the conduct of business in Iowa, including
- 8 but not limited to consumer protection and unfair or deceptive
- 9 trade practice laws and rules.
