## A BILL FOR

An Act exempting from the state individual income tax the
 federal retirement pay of a resident received for military
 service and including retroactive applicability provisions.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 422.7, Code 2014, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 31A. *a.* Subtract, to the extent included, 4 retirement pay received by a resident taxpayer from the federal 5 government for military service performed in the armed forces, 6 the armed forces military reserve, or the national guard. 7 *b.* The exclusion of retirement pay under this subsection is 8 in addition to any exclusion provided under subsection 31. 9 Sec. 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies 10 retroactively to January 1, 2014, for tax years beginning on 11 or after that date.

## EXPLANATION

13The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with14the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

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15 This bill exempts from the individual income tax all 16 retirement pay of an Iowa resident from federal military 17 service in the armed forces, the military reserve, or national 18 guard. The exemption is in addition to the general pension 19 exclusion.

The bill applies retroactively to January 1, 2014, for tax 21 years beginning on or after that date.

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
