

**Senate Study Bill 3165 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act providing for the revocation of certain training  
2 certificates issued to fire fighters.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 100B.2, Code 2014, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. Develop and submit to the state  
4 fire marshal for adoption rules establishing a procedure for  
5 revoking certificates issued for fire service training for fire  
6 fighters convicted of a felony.

7 Sec. 2. Section 100B.7, subsection 2, paragraph c, Code  
8 2014, is amended to read as follows:

9 c. Advise, confer, and consult with the state fire service  
10 and emergency response council in developing rules establishing  
11 minimum standards for fire service training and providing for  
12 the revocation of certificates issued for fire service training  
13 for fire fighters convicted of a felony.

14 EXPLANATION

15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
16 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

17 This bill directs the state fire service and emergency  
18 response council to develop and submit to the state fire  
19 marshal for adoption rules establishing a procedure for  
20 revoking certificates issued for fire service training for fire  
21 fighters convicted of a felony. The bill provides that the  
22 administrator of the fire service training bureau advise the  
23 council in developing these rules.
