- 1 An Act relating to the display of registration plates on
- 2 certain motor vehicles with front bumpers which are low to
- 3 the ground.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.37, subsection 2, Code 2015, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 2. Registration plates issued for a A motor vehicle which
- 4 is model year 1948 or older, and is reconstructed or specially
- 5 constructed vehicles built to resemble a model year 1948
- 6 vehicle or older, or which was originally manufactured with a
- 7 front bumper that sits twenty-four inches from the ground or
- 8 <u>less</u>, other than a truck registered for more than five tons, <u>a</u>
- 9 motorcycle, or a truck tractor, may display one registration
- 10 plate on the rear of the vehicle if the other registration
- 11 plate issued to the vehicle is carried in the vehicle at all
- 12 times when the vehicle is operated on a public highway.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 16 Generally, a motor vehicle is required to display two
- 17 registration plates, with one on the front of the vehicle
- 18 and one on the rear of the vehicle. Current law allows
- 19 motor vehicles which are model year 1948 or older, or are
- 20 reconstructed or specially constructed to resemble a model year
- 21 1948 vehicle or older, to display only one registration plate
- 22 on the rear of the vehicle if the other registration plate
- 23 issued to the vehicle is carried in the vehicle at all times
- 24 when the vehicle is operated on a public highway.
- 25 This bill broadens that exception to include any motor
- 26 vehicle originally manufactured with a front bumper that sits
- 27 24 inches from the ground or less.
- 28 The scheduled fine for incorrect display of registration
- 29 plates in violation of Code section 321.37 is \$20.
