- 1 An Act increasing the penalty for lending a motor vehicle to
- 2 a person whose driver's license has been revoked due to a
- 3 conviction for operating-while-intoxicated.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321J.4B, subsection 4, Code 2015, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 4. An owner of a motor vehicle impounded or immobilized under this section, who knows of, should have known of,
- 5 or gives consent to the operation of, the motor vehicle in
- 6 violation of subsection 2, paragraph "a", subparagraph (2),
- 7 shall be both of the following:
- 8 a. Guilty of a simple serious misdemeanor, and.
- 9 b. Jointly and severally liable for any damages caused
- 10 by the person who operated the motor vehicle, subject to the $\ensuremath{\text{c}}$
- 11 provisions of chapter 668.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 15 Current law prohibits the owner of a motor vehicle from
- 16 allowing the operation of the motor vehicle by a person whose
- 17 driver's license has been suspended, denied, revoked, or
- 18 barred due to a conviction for operating-while-intoxicated. A
- 19 violation of this provision is a simple misdemeanor. A simple
- 20 misdemeanor is punishable by up to 30 days in prison and a \$625
- 21 fine under Code section 903.1.
- 22 This bill increases the penalty for a violation of the
- 23 provision to a serious misdemeanor. A serious misdemeanor is
- 24 punishable by up to one year in prison and a \$1,875 fine under
- 25 Code section 903.1.
