A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring newborn metabolic screenings to include
2 screening for certain lysosomal storage disorders.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEWBORN METABOLIC SCREENING — INCLUSION OF
2 LYSOSOMAL STORAGE DISORDERS. Pursuant to section 136A.8,
3 the center for congenital and inherited disorders, with the
4 assistance of the department of public health, shall adopt
5 rules to require the screening of newborns for the following
6 lysosomal storage disorders as part of the newborn metabolic
7 screening pursuant to section 136A.5:

- 8 1. Globoid cell leukodystrophy (Krabbe).
- 9 2. Fabry.
- 10 3. Pompe.
- 11 4. Niemann-Pick.
- 12 5. Gaucher.
- 13 6. Hurler syndrome (MPS I).

14 EXPLANATION

15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
16 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

17 This bill directs the center for congenital and inherited
18 disorders with the assistance of the department of public
19 health to adopt rules to require the screening of newborns
20 for the six specified lysosomal storage disorders (LSDs) as
21 part of the newborn metabolic screening. The LSDs specified
22 are: Globoid cell leukodystrophy (Krabbe), Fabry, Pompe,
23 Niemann-Pick, Gaucher, and Hurler syndrome (MPS I).
