## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the operation of a motor vehicle in the far
- 2 left lane of a divided, multilaned highway at a speed under
- 3 the posted speed limit, and providing a penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 155

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.297, Code 2015, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. a. A person operating a motor vehicle
- 4 in the far left lane of a divided, multilaned highway shall not
- 5 operate the vehicle at a speed of ten miles per hour or more
- 6 under the posted speed limit if the person knows or reasonably
- 7 should know that the operator of another motor vehicle in the
- 8 far left lane traveling in the same direction as the person is
- 9 attempting to overtake the person from the rear at a higher
- 10 rate of speed.
- ll b. This subsection shall not apply if the person is
- 12 attempting to overtake the operator of another motor vehicle
- 13 traveling in the same direction as the person or if the person
- 14 is preparing to make a left turn.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 18 This bill prohibits a person operating a motor vehicle
- 19 in the far left lane of a divided, multilaned highway from
- 20 driving at a speed of 10 miles per hour or more under the
- 21 posted speed limit if the person knows or reasonably should
- 22 know that another driver in the far left lane traveling in the
- 23 same direction as the person is attempting to overtake the
- 24 person from the rear at a higher rate of speed. The bill does
- 25 not apply to a person attempting to overtake another driver
- 26 traveling in the same direction as the person or to a person
- 27 preparing to make a left turn.
- 28 Current law provides a scheduled fine for a violation of this
- 29 section of \$100.
