A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring that county sheriffs be elected on a
- 2 nonpartisan basis and including effective date provisions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 39.17, Code 2016, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 39.17 County officers.
- 4 l. There shall be elected in each county at the general
- 5 election to be held in the year 1976 and every four years
- 6 thereafter, an auditor and a sheriff, each to hold office for a
- 7 term of four years.
- 8 2. There shall be elected in each county at the general
- 9 election to be held in 1974 and each four years thereafter, a
- 10 treasurer, a recorder, and a county attorney who shall, each to
- 11 hold office for a term of four years.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 39.21, Code 2016, is amended to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 39.21 Nonpartisan offices.
- 15 l. There shall be elected at each general election, on a
- 16 nonpartisan basis, the following officers:
- 17 1. County public hospital trustees as required by
- 18 section 347.25.
- 19 2. b. Soil and water conservation district commissioners
- 20 as required by section 161A.5.
- 21 $\frac{3}{100}$ c. County agricultural extension council members as
- 22 provided in section 176A.6.
- 23 4. d. Township officers as provided in section 39.22,
- 24 subsection 2.
- 25 2. There shall be elected in each county at the general
- 26 election to be held in the year 2016 and every four years
- 27 thereafter, on a nonpartisan basis, a sheriff, to hold office
- 28 for a term of four years.
- Sec. 3. Section 69.14A, subsection 2, unnumbered paragraph
- 30 1, Code 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- 31 A vacancy in any of the offices listed in section 39.17 or
- 32 in the office of sheriff shall be filled by one of the two

- 34 Sec. 4. Section 69.14A, subsection 4, Code 2016, is amended
- 35 to read as follows:

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- 1 4. Notwithstanding subsections 1 and 2, if a nomination
- 2 has been made at the primary election for an a partisan office
- 3 in which a vacancy has been filled by appointment, the office
- 4 shall be filled at the next general election, and not at any
- 5 special election in the same political subdivision.
- 6 Sec. 5. Section 97B.49C, subsection 1, paragraph e, Code
- 7 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 e. "Sheriff" means a county sheriff as defined in elected or
- 9 appointed to that office as described in section 39.17 331.651.
- 10 Sec. 6. Section 97B.49G, subsection 7, paragraph a,
- 11 subparagraph (3), subparagraph division (a), Code 2016, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) As a county sheriff as defined in elected or appointed
- 14 to that office as described in section 39.17 331.651.
- 15 Sec. 7. Section 331.651, subsection 1, Code 2016, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 l. The office of sheriff is an a nonpartisan elective
- 18 office. However, if a vacancy occurs in the office, the first
- 19 deputy shall assume the office after qualifying as provided in
- 20 this section. The first deputy shall hold the office until
- 21 a successor is appointed or elected to the unexpired term
- 22 as provided in chapter 69 section 69.14A. If a sheriff is
- 23 suspended from office, the district court may appoint a sheriff
- 24 until a temporary appointment is made by the board as provided
- 25 in section 66.19.
- Sec. 8. Section 331.661, subsection 3, Code 2016, is amended
- 27 to read as follows:
- 28 3. The office of multicounty sheriff is created effective on
- 29 January 1 of the year following the next general election at
- 30 which the county sheriff is elected as provided by this section
- 31 and section 39.17 39.21.
- 32 Sec. 9. IMPLEMENTATION IOWA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT
- 33 SYSTEM. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act amending
- 34 sections 97B.49C and 97B.49G, the definition of sheriff in
- 35 those sections shall include those persons who qualified as a

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- 1 sheriff prior to the effective date of this Act.
- 2 Sec. 10. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed
- 3 of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 4 EXPLANATION
- 5 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 6 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 7 This bill provides that county sheriffs shall be elected
- 8 on a nonpartisan basis beginning with the general election in
- 9 November 2016. The bill also provides that vacancies in the
- 10 office of sheriff shall be filled in the manner provided for
- 11 partisan county offices.
- 12 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
