An Act requiring that county auditors be elected on a
 nonpartisan basis and including effective date provisions.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 331.501, subsection 1, Code 2016, is amended 6 7 to read as follows: The office of auditor is an a nonpartisan elective office 8 1. 9 except that if a vacancy occurs in the office, a successor 10 shall be elected or appointed to the unexpired term as provided 11 in chapter 69 section 69.14A. 12 Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of 13 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. 14 EXPLANATION 15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 16 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

17 This bill provides that county auditors shall be elected 18 on a nonpartisan basis beginning with the general election in 19 November 2016. The bill also provides that vacancies in the 20 office of auditor shall be filled in the manner provided for 21 partisan county offices.
